## 4 Doves First Aid Training Risk Assessment Policy

#### 1. Introduction

- 1.1 This policy contains a check list for 4 Doves First Aid Training staff to utilise. The templates have been developed for courses commonly delivered by this Centre.
- 1.2 Each venue and course has it's own hazards and must be risk assessed by staff on the day.
- 1.3 4 Doves First Aid Training will require supporting rationale if a decision is made not to deliver training to customers on health and safety grounds.
- 1.4 This document is designed to summarise issues for the 4 Doves First Aid Training trainer/ assessor visiting new educational premises for perhaps the first time for the delivery of scenario based, first aid training.

### 2 Example Risk Assessments

2.1 Risk Assessment for delivering first aid qualification at a new training venue
