#### Winter Series 2025-26

The Winter Series competitions are non-qualifying for handicap purposes.

Remember, if you are playing the competition as part of a social 18 holes, you must play your 9 hole competition round first.

Preferred lies (Lift, clean and place) may be taken from all fairways. Please note that most fairways have a 2 mower width '1st cut' around them which is not eligible for preferred lies.

All bunkers will be GUR for the Winter Series. If you go in a bunker you should lift your ball and go back in line with the bunker and the flag to drop. If your drop is on a fairway you may then take a preferred lie.

## **Scorecard Completion**

- 1. All Winter Series competitions will be played on the Par 3 course and that is the part of the scorecard that should be completed.
- 2. To Assist in the timely and accurate production of competition results (and to comply with the club's competition rules) please enter as a minimum, the details shown below on your scorecard before exchanging cards with a playing partner who is also playing in the competition.

- 3. The scorecard must be legible or it will be discounted.
- 4. Exchange scorecards with a playing partner so everyone is marking someone else's card.
- 5. For each hole record the total number of strokes taken by the person who's card you are marking in column A.
- 6. You are advised to record your total number of strokes for each hole in the 'Markers Score' column to assist checking and certifying at the end.
- 7. At the end of the round you should sign in the box marked 'Markers Signature'. By doing so you are certifying as correct your fellow competitors' score.
- 8. Markers should then return cards to the players.
- 9. When you receive your card it is your responsibility to check that it is correct and then sign in the box marked 'Players signature'.
- 10. Place your completed card in the score box in the shop
- N.B. Calculation of net scores and stableford points is optional.
