Plasmage® Aftercare Instructions

Immediately after treatment, there may be a burning sensation. This is normal and will subside within several hours. If it is particularly uncomfortable or persists for a longer period of time, an anti-inflammatory such as ibuprofen may be taken.

Following treatment it is normal to have some swelling. This may be significant for people being treated around the eye area and may last for several days. It may lead to some interference with vision in the initial period - obviously, it would be inadvisable to drive if this is the case.

Cold compresses may be applied for short periods of time to help reduce the swelling.

If the swelling is more severe, an anti-inflammatory medication and/or anti-histamines may help reduce the swelling. **Please do not apply any ointments or creams to the treated areas other than directed by your clinician.**

Crusting will develop over the treated area, this will initially be brown or black on the skin surface and will flake off over the following 5-10 days. Occasionally it may take over 2 weeks to completely disappear. It is essential to NOT pick this crusting as this may lead to infection or scarring.

Occasionally the treated area may become a little weepy - this is part of the normal healing process and will improve with time. However, if the area becomes red or hot or there is any pus present, please contact

Kelly Costello for advice as this may suggest an infection has developed.

It is essential to keep the treated area clean and dry. Wash your hands before touching the treated area. Wash the treated area twice daily with a mild facial cleanser and pat dry with a clean towel. Please do not apply any moisturisers, serums etc. until the skin has healed.

Protect the treated areas with a broad spectrum sunscreen at least 30SPF. This must be applied regularly every few hours when outside. You must continue to protect the skin for 8 weeks post procedure. Sunglasses should also be worn when outside, if the eye area has been treated.

Kelly has aftercare packs containing suitable products, available to purchase at clinic if required.

Do not apply a plaster or an occlusive dressing to the treated area - this will likely cause the area to scar!

More than one treatment may be necessary to achieve optimal results, this can be arranged if necessary for around 6-8 weeks after the initial treatment.

A review appointment should be booked via the online booking system (aesthetic review appointment) for approximately 7-10 days post-procedure. It is important to attend to enable Kelly to assess the healing of the treated area.
