Dr. Peter Steele

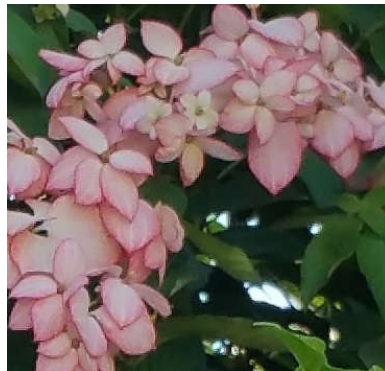
Dr. Steele will be speaking on MEDICINAL HERBS

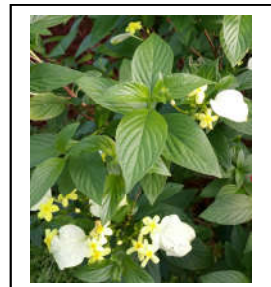
Basil

varieties are salmon, pink and white. The dainty Dwarf

Yellow Mussaenda is not as spectacular as the standard variety. The flowers are small bright yellow star-shaped corollas with orange centers, joined by the palest creamy yellow bracts that look like white wings.
