Once again, the Hollywood Garden Club enjoyed a propagation class at Susan's home on March 25. Good food and a walking tour of Susan's garden were on the menu.



Susan demonstrated air-layering on this croton. Roots will form on the stem where the bark was removed on a 1-2" section. The exposed stem is then wrapped in wet sphagnum moss and covered with aluminum foil, now wait about 4-6 weeks. When the foil feels firm and roots have developed, the air-layered section can be removed from the mother plant and placed in a pot to further develop its roots before being planted directly into the ground.

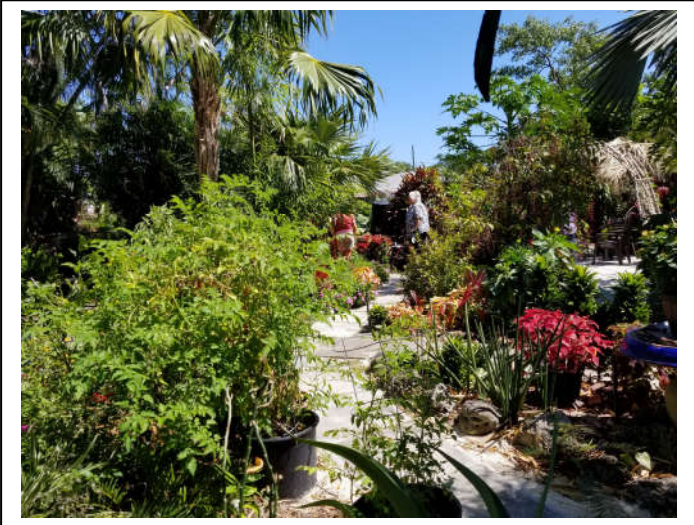
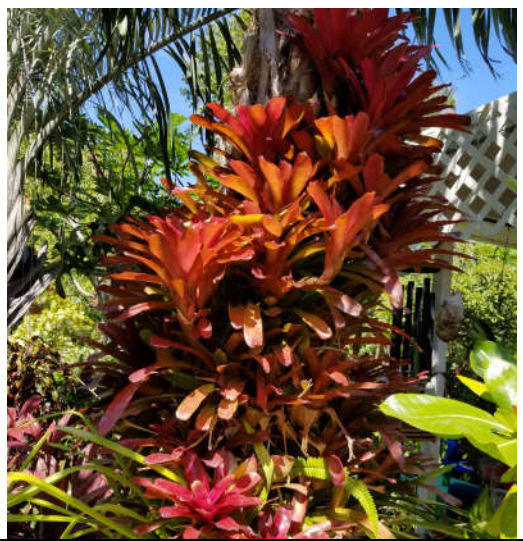
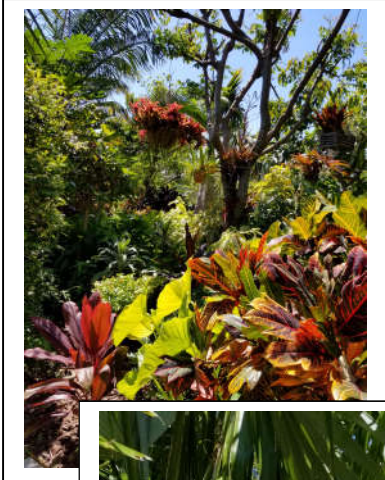
