Elaine provided the before picture of her garden plot, 3' x 6'. Most of us would say this is too small to work with and creat a butterfly garden but Elaine took on the challenge and here are the results:

Pictures do not do justice to the experience of Butterfly World. You walk through gardens with thousands of butterflies flying freely around you.


