

- There will be no bar or socializing prior to or following the curling game. Please retrieve your belongings from the locker rooms as the locker rooms will be closed while in the orange phase.
- We encourage people to come to the club prepared to curl except for donning their curling shoes. Once the game is over, we are asking everyone to leave the club as soon as possible with no interaction with another group of curlers.
- A coat rack has been placed in the lounge area to hold outerwear. Boots should be left in an orderly fashion within close proximity to the coat rack.
- Teams should enter the ice shed in order to which ice they are playing on.
- One person per draw should be assigned prior to every game to remind everyone of club safety protocols.
- Skips, assign one person to take a package of disinfecting wipes to their assigned ice, so rock handles and scoreboard can be wiped down following your game and to return them to the lounge area when they leave the ice shed.
- Following the game, skips assign a team member to clean the rock handles, using the disinfecting wipes provided and one person, who is looking after posting the scores, to wipe down the scoreboard numbers.
- If you should decide not to curl, due to personal reasons during the Orange Alert Level, please advise your league coordinator, so they can make arrangement with the opposing team. Teams may have to be reduced to three members.
- Team Skips or a designated person need to conduct **"ACTIVE SCREENING"**. Active screening means that this person must ask all the questions on GNB's symptom checklist, to everyone entering the club. A copy will be at the club.
- League coordinators or a designated person must request all patrons to sanitize their hands upon entrance to the premises.
