We have had a few Plumbing issues over the year with complaints of sewer smells, taps running continually and running up the water bill slightly and taps leaking in kitchen, which were replaced. We also had to have a couple of toilets repaired due to them running continually.

We have had a couple of windstorms which has resulted in some siding being torn off, which have been repaired by Oliver Earle.

We had a 40-gallon hot water tank installed this Spring so that we can turn the boiler off for the summer months and use the electric to heat the water.

Myles has advised that there is a brine leak which will need to be repaired before our curling season starts again.

Replacement of light bulbs has been ongoing all year.
