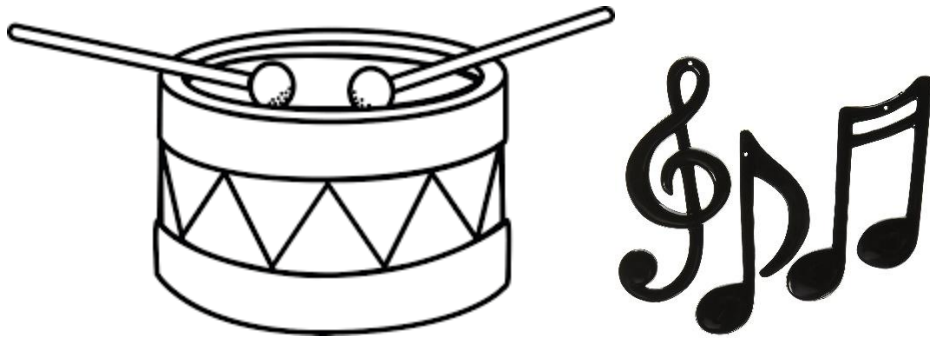

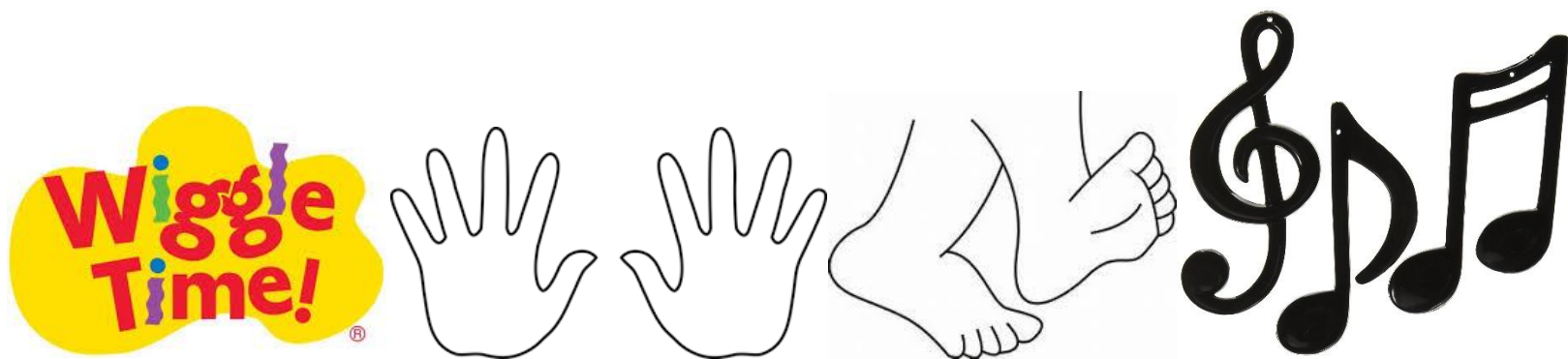

With my little hands I go clap, clap, clap

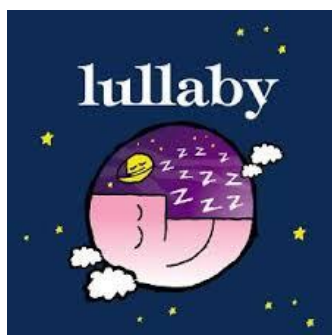
With my little feet I go tap, tap, tap
