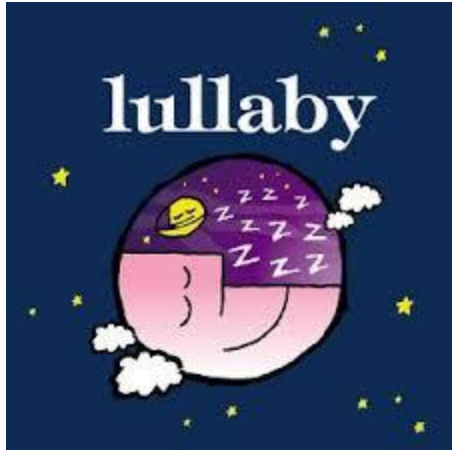




Golden slumbers kiss your eyes,
