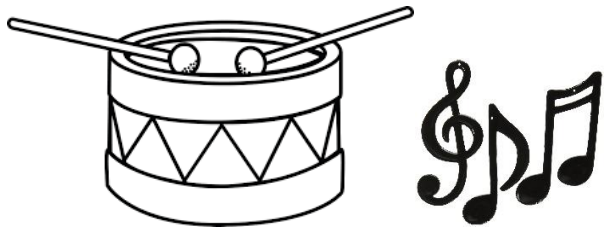

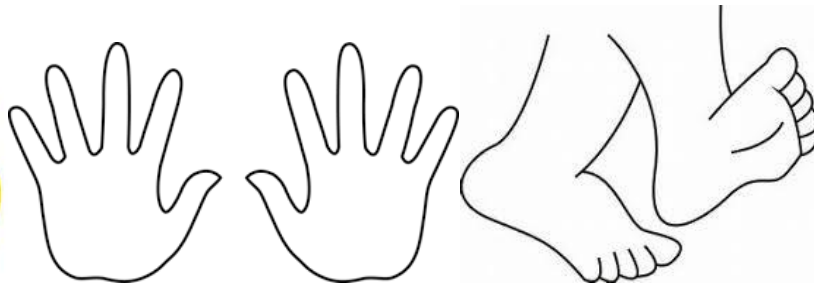


## TAPPING

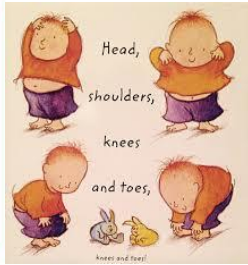
There's a cobbler down the street,

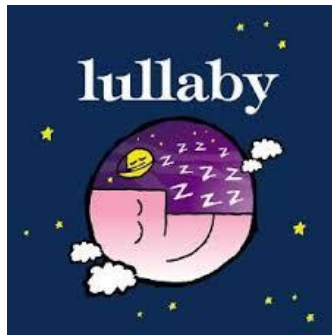
