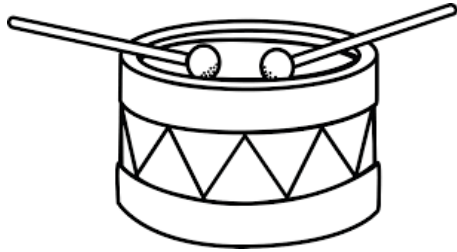

All across the ground!

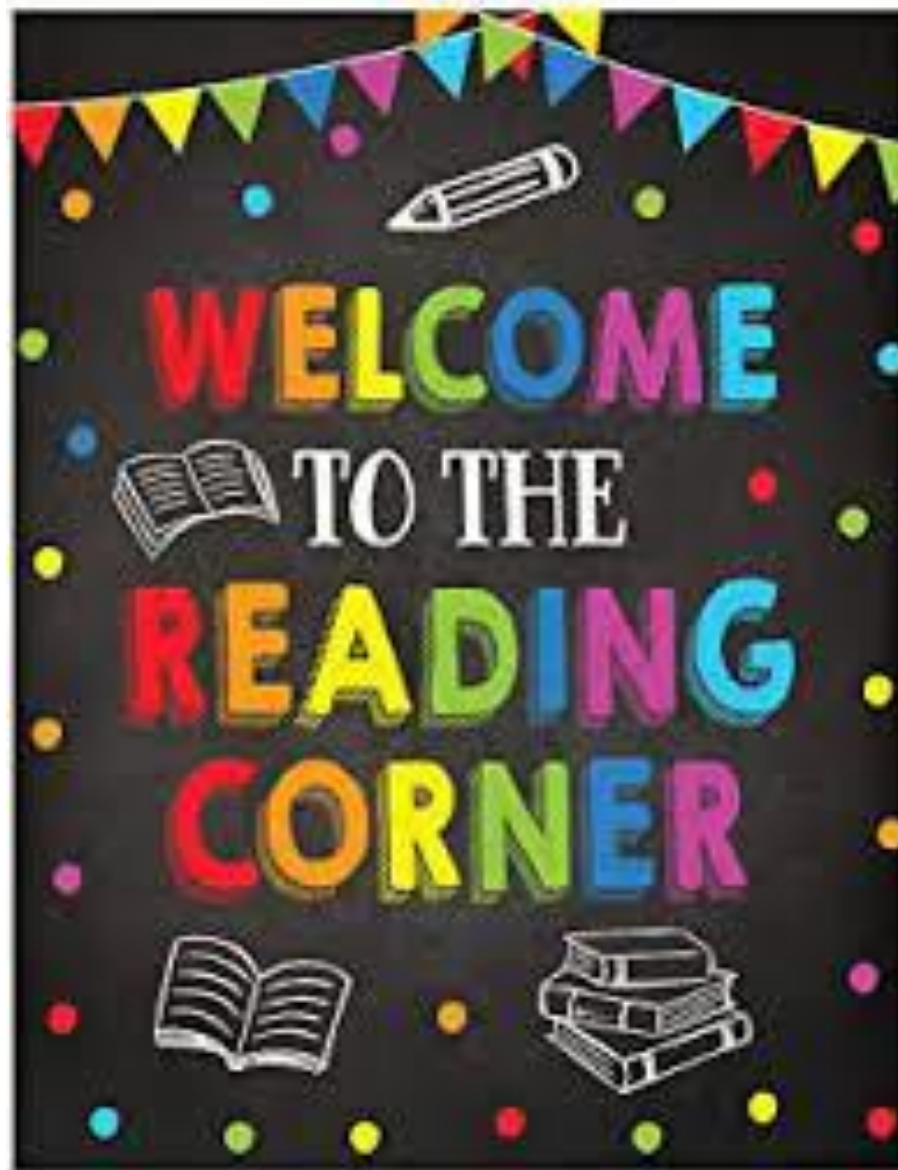


Bye oh bye up, bye oh bye down.
