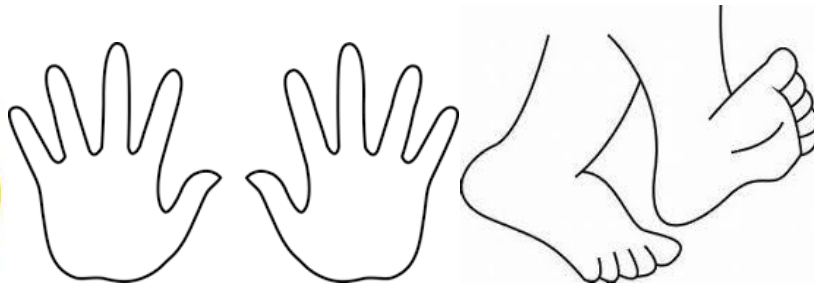

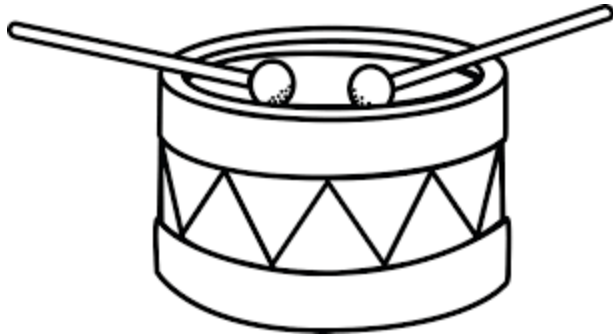

Gives you a mousy kiss

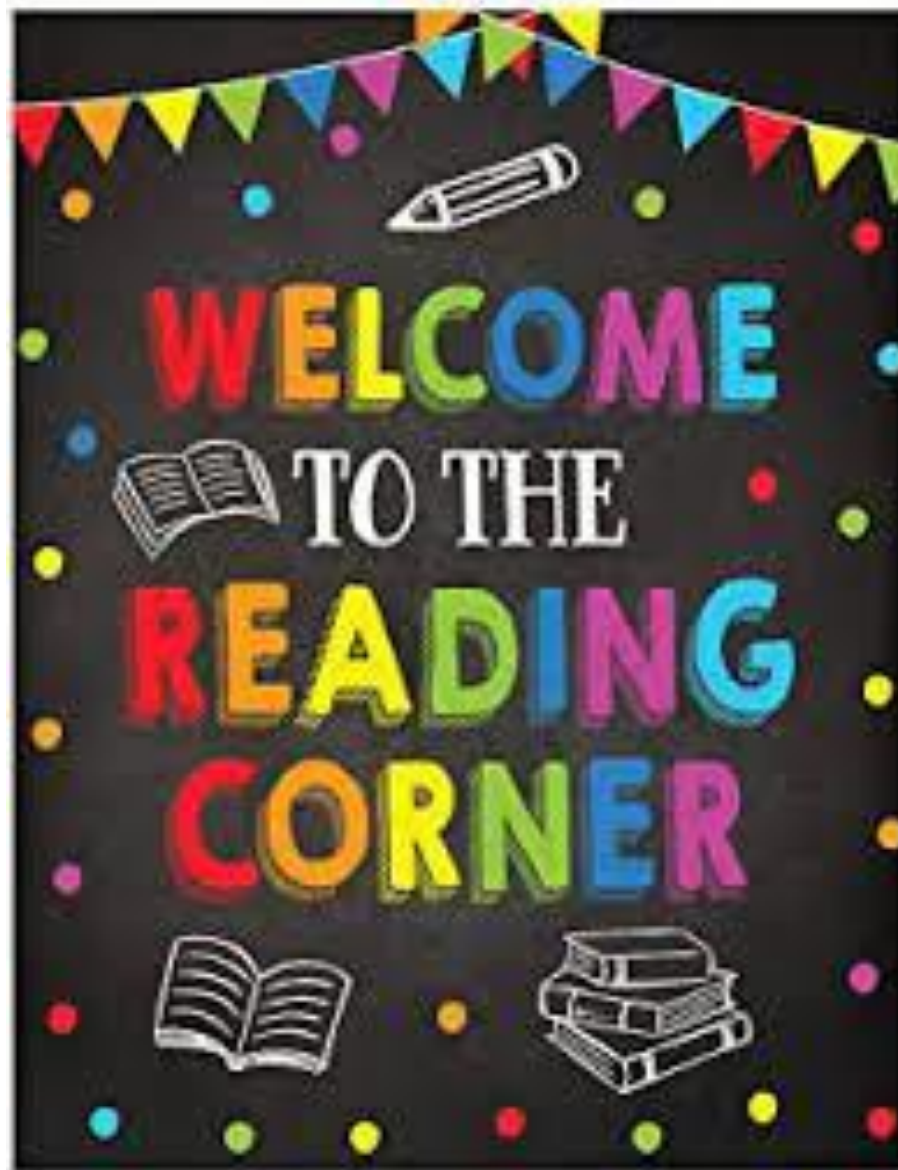


Ching-a-swing Cheetahs, turn around,

Ching-a-swing Cheetahs, touch the ground,

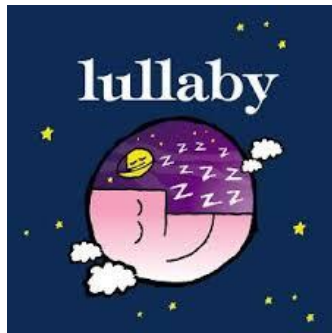
Ching-a-swing Cheetahs, show your spots,
