He went right up there!*

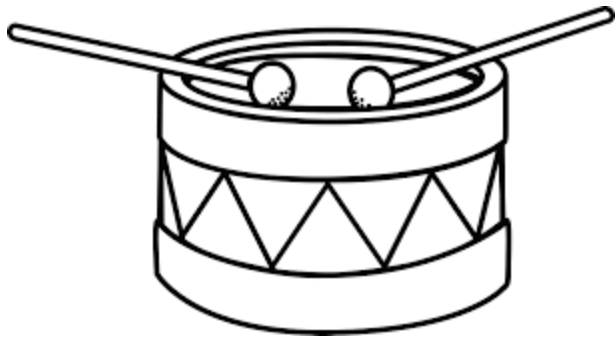


TAPPING

Stop, stop, stop, stop; The light is turning red*

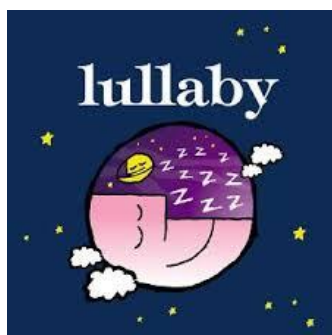
*The light is turning green; The light is turning green
