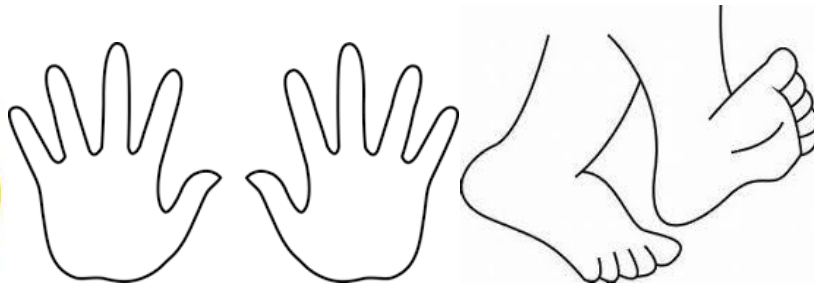

OOOOOOO went the wind and out went the light.

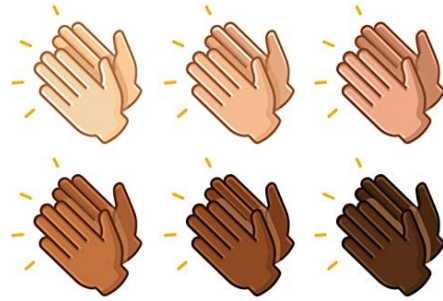


*Circle to the left the old brass wagon,

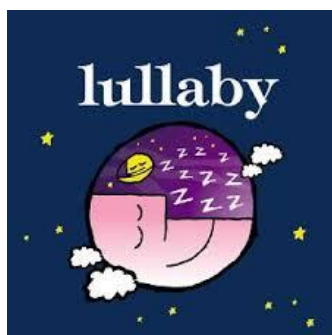
