Tips for Getting Started

- CONSIDER Who, in your circle, is passionate about their community and would be interested in learning about our work during uplifting 30-minute virtual presentation? Friends, neighbors, colleagues, and others. All are welcome.
- 2. CONNECT Extend an invitation by phone or text. Email works well too. Feel free to adjust the sample script below.

You will not be asked for money. Just your opinions on their work. The next presentation is (insert from website.) Is this something you would like to attend?"

- 3. REGISTER One-Hour Ambassadors register their guests at https://seedsowerinc.org/events. Only name and email are needed. Ambassadors are encouraged to complete a TEST registration by adding the word TEST anywhere in the name field. Input an accurate email so you receive an auto confirmation and understand the simple process. Invitees can also register on their own.
- 4. **REMINDER** Connect with invitees a few days before the presentation with a reminder phone call, text, or email.
