Now we are capable and have total energy, and we can say "Ready, Set, Go"!




About Us

When was the last time you really looked at a spiderweb?


Did you ever notice how a spider web holds water after a rainstorm? And, how once you disturb the web the water is released? That is the principle behind the moisture matrix of glyceryl acrylate/acrylic acid copolymer technology. The moisture matrices created are called clathrates. 
