Fish Habitat Restoration



- Natural Habitat Deteriorates Within 7 to 10 Years
- MDC Recommends 2 to 3 Areas Per Surface Acre
- Each Habitat Should Be Approximately 10 by 15 Feet
- Place In Water From 0 to 20 Feet Of Depth
- Potential Placement Along Dams/Roads
- Mark New Habitat With GPS Coordinates

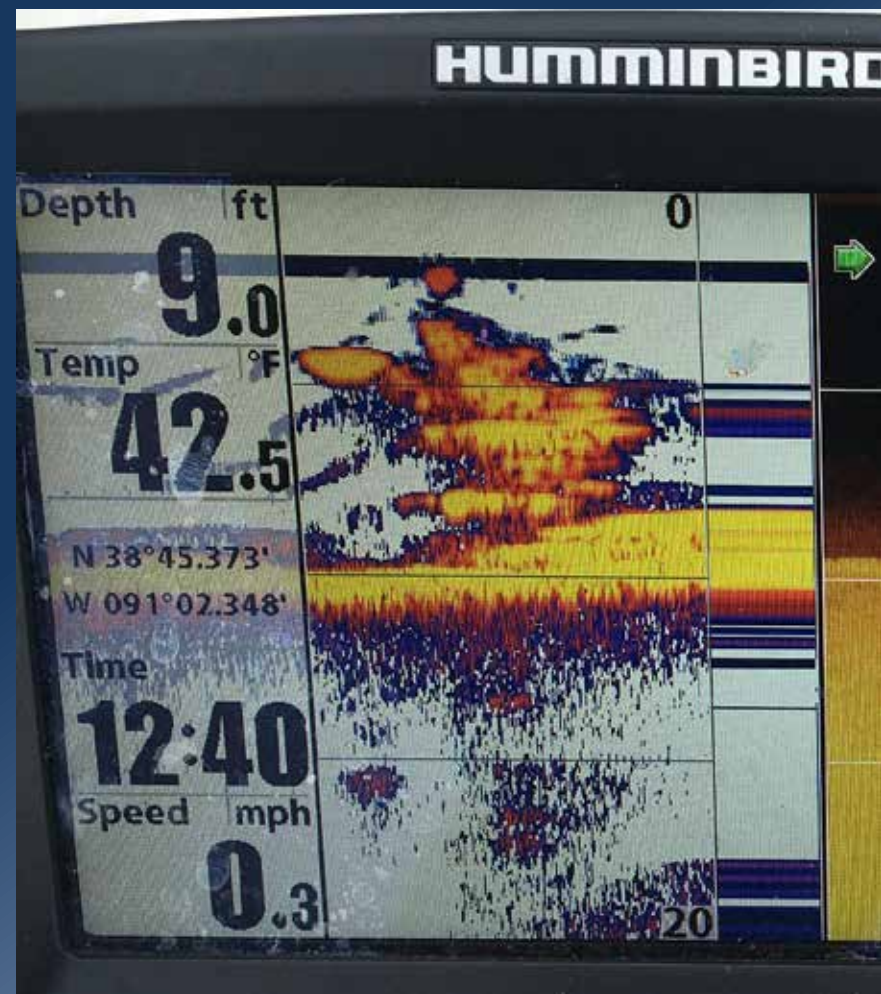
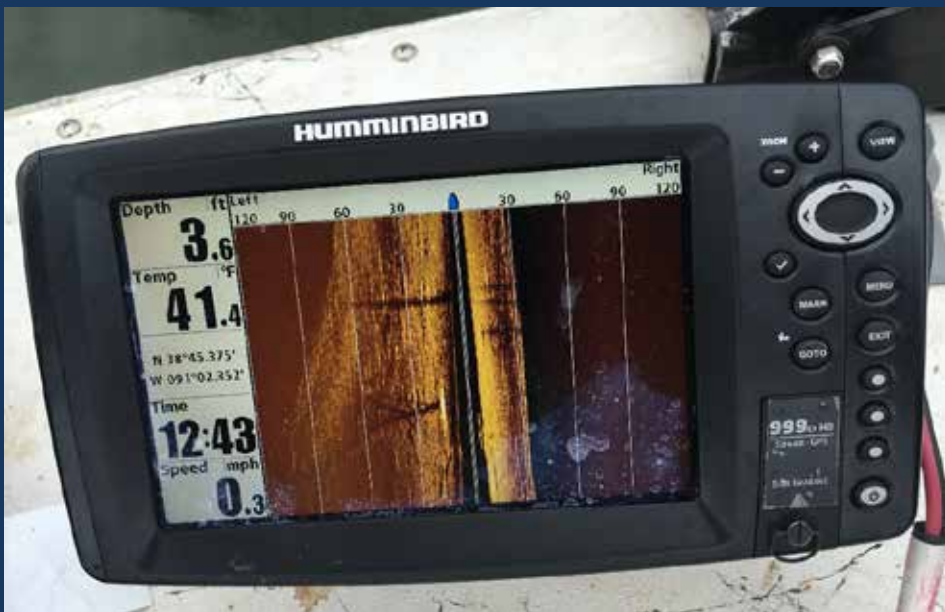

Fish Habitat Work Day Lessons Learned

- Use a Barge to Place Structures
- Cut More Cedar Trees to Keep Work Going
- Use Quick Setting Concrete
 - - Note old hard concrete does not work
- Adequate Supply of Small Diameter PVC for Limbs
- Work in Teams

Also, 5 Grass Carp Close to 60 pounds each

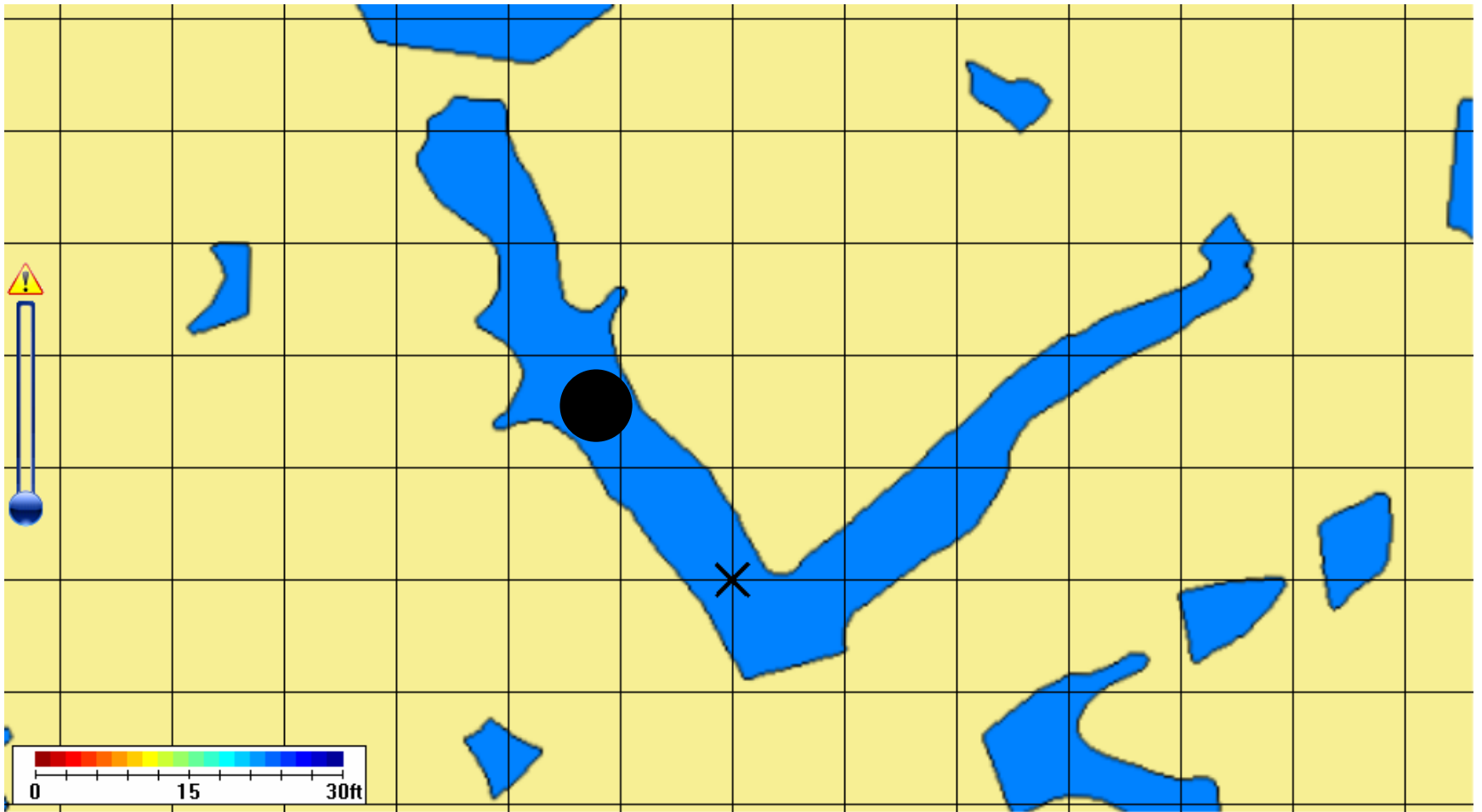

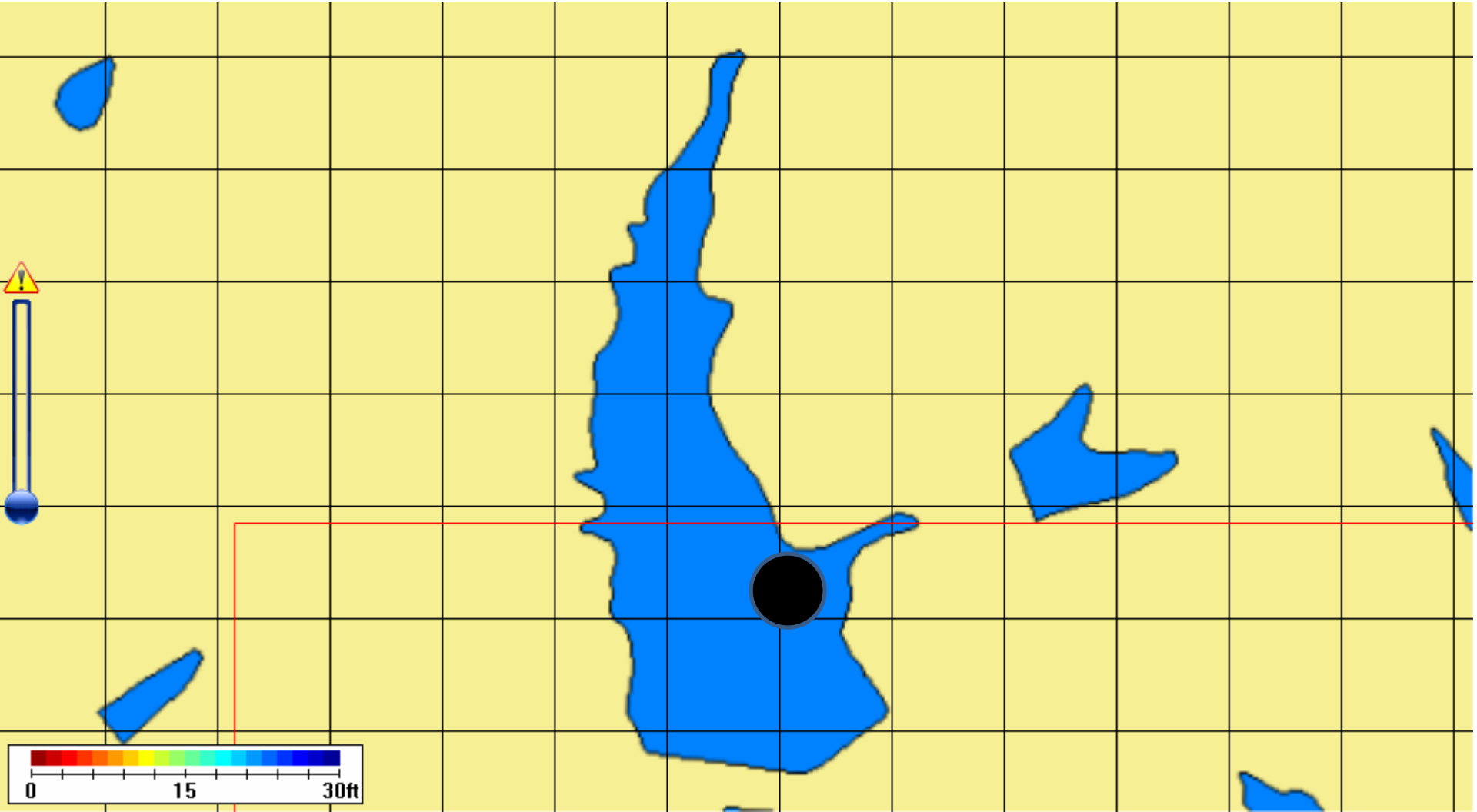

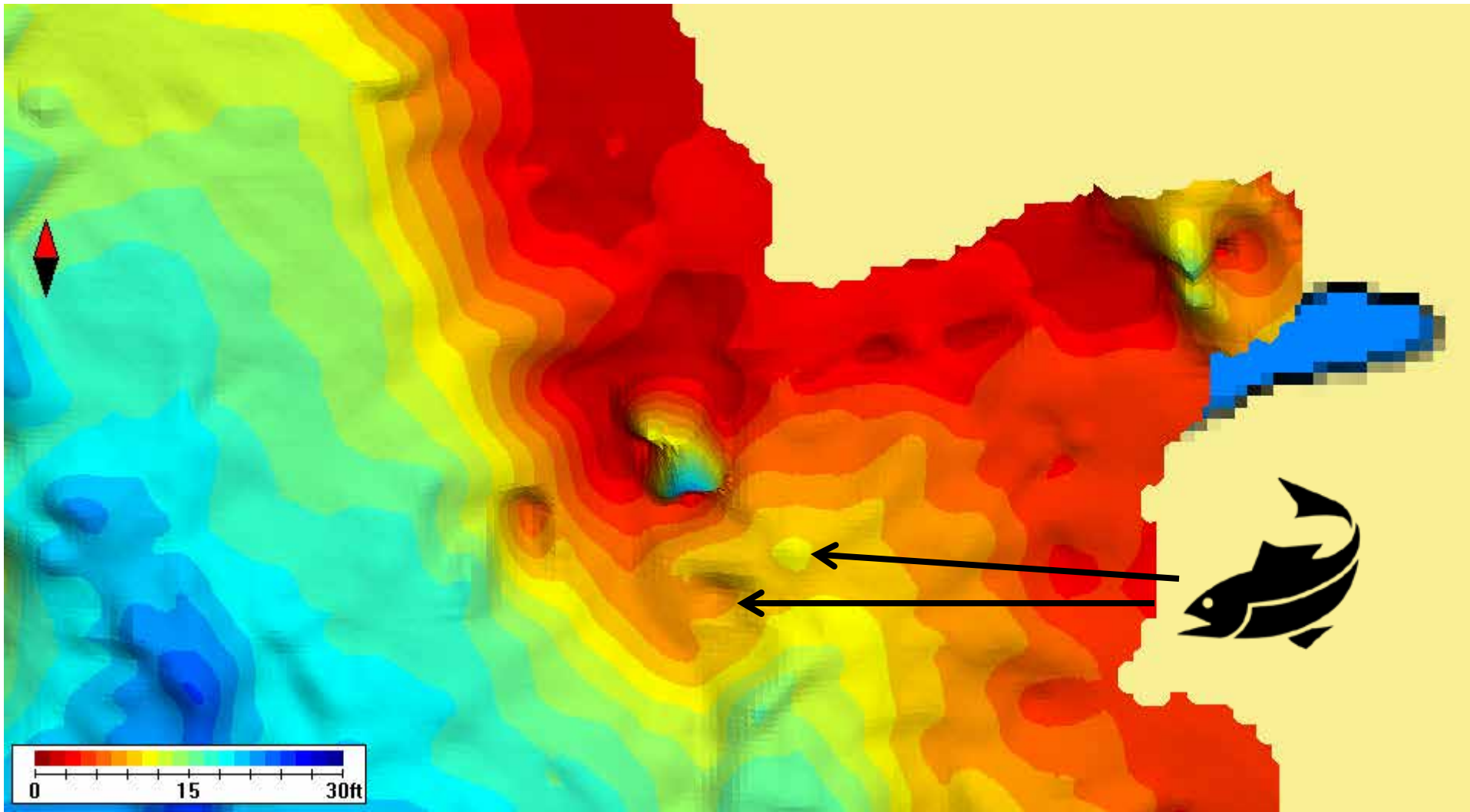
Deep Pots In Lake Innsbrook



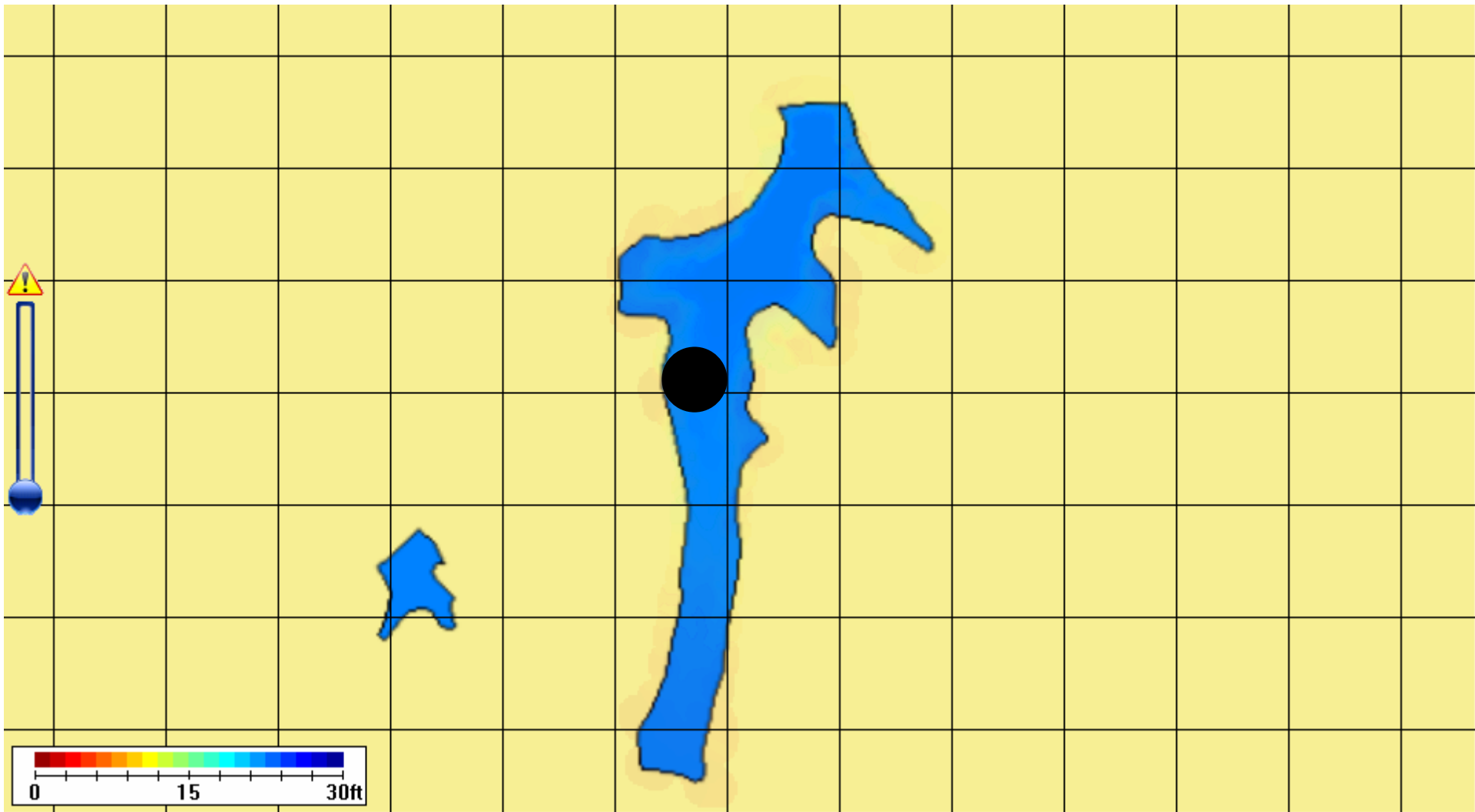

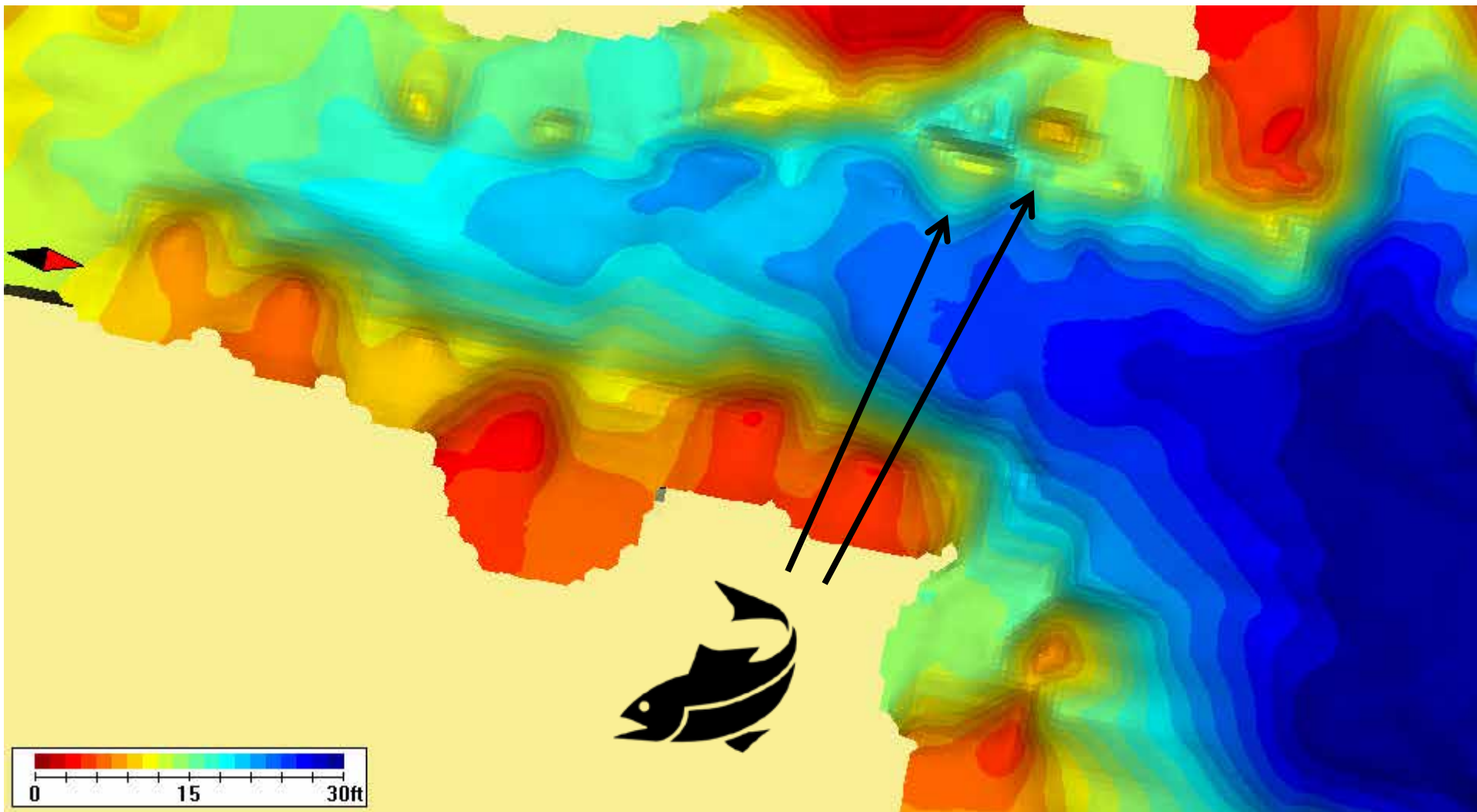
Structure Inside Lucern Point

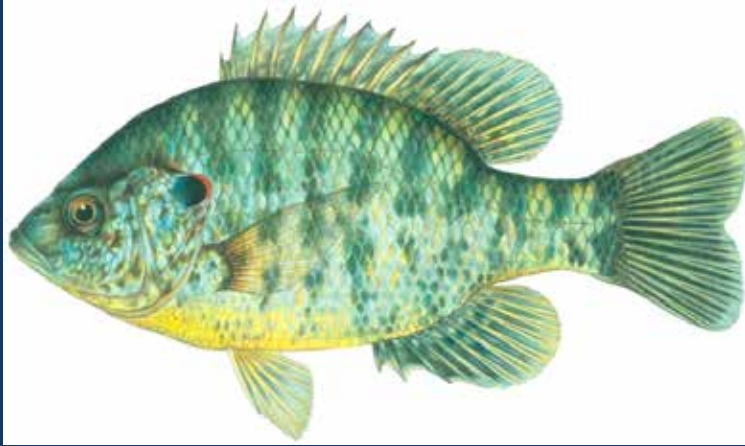
Specific Objectives for Each Lake



- Types Of Fish Species
 - Bass, Bluegill, Catfish, Redear Sunfish, Grass Carp
- Quality of Fishing,
 - A lot of Fish To Catch, 5 to 12 per Hour
 - Or
 - Larger Fish, 3 to 4 per Hour (Largemouth Bass)
- Different Species
 - Walleye, Perch, etc.

The green sunfish is thick-bodied with a large mouth. The upper jaw extends to about the middle of the eye. The back and sides are bluish green, grading to pale yellow or white on the belly.
