# About the Artists

#### **Robert Fabris**

Robert has been designing and creating custom made, one-of-a-kind furniture for many years. He has a real passion for staying true to the natural beauty of the wood that he works with to create designs that enhance and preserve its characteristics. From his studio workshop in Melbourne's East, Robert creates pieces of furniture from the highest quality timber that he carefully selects to create designs that each tell a different story.



#### **Peter Hall**

Repurposing a piece of timber destined for the hard garbage collection or exposing the distinctive features revealed when a tree is felled is the inspiration behind much of Peter's work. He seeks to create a functional and attractive piece with least disturbance to the character of the timber. So long as functionality is maintained, Peter is not averse to displaying the naturally occurring features of timber such as live edges, bark, insect habitation, grains, knots and cracks. These often become the highlights of Peter's work.

Peter's style might be described as rustic, natural and elegantly simple. The piece of furniture or timber piece on the sideboard might be hundreds of years old and with the proper care will continue to serve us well. "We should enjoy the pieces and respect them" says Peter.



#### **Sally Nugent**

Engineer, shaman, and business owner with a passion to create. "I love watching the wood come to life as it is planed and fashioned into shapes. People ask what am I going to make, and I will often reply that it depends on what the timber wants to be."



#### Jack O'Brien

Jack is a furniture maker and antique restorer with a passion for authentic, thoughtful design. Taking cues from fine antiques and incorporating contemporary Australian timbers, Jack aims to create valued pieces of heirloom furniture that withstand the test of time.





# Chairs


## Deco Bergère

Inspired by the geometric lines of 1920's Art deco furniture, this chair combines the comfort of upholstered club chairs with the beauty of Australian timber. Constructed in salvaged Australia Silky

oak sourced from northern NSW and finished in an eco-friendly hard wax oil. Accentuating the unique grain of this native timber whilst providing robust protection for everyday use.

This chair has been designed with comfort in mind. The seat and back are coopered, and curve to match the contours of the body. A feature that not only lends itself to comfort, but gives the chair rigidity and strength. The seat hangs suspended from the leg structure, which itself also forms the arms. These feature 'finger joints' at the juncture, in the very place one's fingers rest whilst sitting.

Thoughtfully built with a gentle recline, this chair invites the sitter to sink in, and lounge in ergonomic comfort.

## Rhodda Chair

This chair is crafted from Redgum, a timber sourced from the Murray River region of Victoria. It's rich deep hues and fine grain patterns tell the story of the river's history. Black Ancient Redgum has been used to connect the two back slats. Every curve and angle of this chair has been thoughtfully designed for optimal comfort and lumbar support. The backrest of the chair mimics the graceful flow of the Murray River, creating an organic, dynamic feel that's both visually captivating and structurally sound. The legs are rounded, providing stability and elegance. This piece has been designed to stand the test of time.

# Redgum Chaise

Handcrafted from exquisite Redgum timber, this chaise showcases the beauty of this unique timber. Its curves, created through a delicate bending process, make it not just a piece of furniture but a sculpture in its own right. The flowing lines and ergonomic design provide both comfort and aesthetic pleasure. The piece is finished with a high-quality eco-friendly hard wax oil, preserving the wood's

natural beauty while ensuring longevity. The padding is of a high-quality navy blue leather. The artist drew inspiration from the natural world and the organic flow of life. The graceful lines and curves of this piece evoke the sense of movement and balance found in nature, making it a harmonious addition to any space.

## **Ergonomic stool**

This perch is a three legged seat of ergonomic design ideal for a range of uses. Unlike a traditional four-legged stool where the occupants sit with legs on the front rung and the body hunched forward, the perch has a seat which slopes forward and the occupant's feet should be flat on the ground. This improves the user's posture keeping the back straight. The perch can be lowered by cutting material off the legs.
