WBC MuayThai _____ committee official sanctioning of the reference bout is expressly subject to the promoter's complete and timely compliance with the administrative requirements mandated by the WBC MuayThai Rules & Regulations as detailed below:

The WBC MuayThai _____ committee is pleased to issue the official approval to sanction the upcoming vacant WBC MuayThai _____ title fight between _____ and _____, to be held on _____, _____, at _____, _____, _____.

The winner of this bout will become WBC MuayThai _____ champion and will be bound to abide by the WBC MuayThai Rules & Regulations and rulings of the WBC MuayThai executive committee and its president.

Following are the requirements and guidelines with which the promoter must comply to receive full sanctioning, authorization, and certification from the WBC MuayThai for the bout requested by promoters.

1. AGREEMENTS

- A. Promoter must sign the WBC MuayThai Promoter agreement.
- B. Both fighters must sign the WBC fighter's agreement.

**These documents are enclosed with this communication.

2. WEIGH-INS

- A. The promoter is responsible for coordinating and submitting to the WBC MuayThai appointed supervisor the information of both fighters regarding their 30-day pre-fight safety weight check before the scheduled bout.
- B. The promoter is responsible for coordinating and submitting to WBC MuayThai both fighters' information regarding their 14-day weight before the date of the



scheduled bout, just as stated in clause A.

- C. The promoter is responsible for coordinating and submitting to WBC MuayThai both fighters' information regarding their 7-day weight before the date of the scheduled bout, just as stated in clause A.

** The above does not apply in the heavyweight division

- D. The official championship weigh-in must take place from 24 to 30 hours before the time of the show, under the supervision of the WBC MuayThai supervisor

4. **WBC MUAYTHAI RULES & REGULATIONS**

- A. Considering that the WBC is the owner of all WBC MuayThai intellectual property including, but not limited to:
1. its trademarks; and
 2. Any rights associated with any WBC MuayThai championships, awards, belts, and designations; the bout must be governed by the WBC Rules & Regulations in agreement with the local combat sports commission (in jurisdictions where there is a combat sports commission).
 3. All WBC MuayThai Rules & Regulations are available via www.wbcmuaythai.com must be abided, and all decisions taken by the WBC MuayThai are final and accepted.
- B. Promoter must clarify and obtain the corresponding reciprocity with the local combat sports commission regarding the related matters of recognizing and supervising the championship bout
- C. All items from the WBC MuayThai Rules & Regulations must be agreed upon, such as:
- Championship Rules.
 - Gloves to be used.
 - Bandaging of fighters.
 - Antidoping tests
 - Apron seating.
 - Scoring cards, concentration sheet, and other formats to be used.
- Etc.

6. RING OFFICIALS' FEES

- A. The promoter is responsible to pay the fees of all WBC MuayThai appointed ring officials for the proposed bout in accordance with the following:

- B. Payment must be made to the WBC MuayThai supervisor on the day of the weigh-in

7. TRANSPORTATION

The promoter is responsible for the expenses of transportation of the following:

8. HOTEL ACCOMMODATION

- A. WBC supervisor: Deluxe - Superior room
- B. Accommodation must be for one night before the bout and the night of the bout unless otherwise agreed between the supervisor and the promoter.

9. MEALS.

Promoter must provide a meal stipend or provide meals for the WBC supervisor during all applicable days

10. SEATING AND CREDENTIALS

- A. Seat & Table next to the ring for the WBC MuayThai Supervisor.
- B. One photo pass with a location at the ring and access to all areas for WBC MuayThai official photographer (when applicable)

11. VIDEO AND PICTURES

- A. The promoter must send to the WBC MuayThai head office high-resolution pictures of the champion and challenger for promotional purposes.
- B. The promoter must send at least ten high-resolution pictures of the event (weigh-in, fight, press conference, no later than seven days after the fight).
- C. The promoter grants WBC MuayThai permission to use images and footage for non-commercial promotional programs of a maximum length of 59 seconds and officials training matters, but no commercial use whatsoever.

12. FIGHT INSURANCE

The promoter and host promotion are solely responsible for providing life insurance and medical expenses insurance for both fighters in the event of any injuries or loss of life caused in the bout. The promoter recognizes that the WBC MuayThai has no obligation whatsoever and will not be responsible, nor have any responsibility in relation to this matter.



13. PROMOTER'S CHAMPIONSHIP BELT OBLIGATION

The promoter must bring the WBC MuayThai _____ championship belt to the weigh-in ceremony to present the belt for publicity photos and face off photos. The belt will be kept with the WBC MuayThai supervisor, during the contest.
