NORTH UNIT FACTS POTENTIAL PROJECT OPPORTUNITIES

952 irrigators served

58,887 acres irrigated

300 miles open canals, laterals, and pipelines to convey water

On average **200,000** acre-feet of water is diverted each year

Up to **42%** of diverted water lost to end spills, seepage, and evaporation

SAVE water by reducing water conveyance inefficiencies

IMPROVE irrigation water management and agricultural water supply

IMPROVE irrigation water delivery reliability to ensure North Unit Irrigation District irrigators receive the water they need, when they need it

REDUCE patron energy consumption and costs

MINIMIZE potential for injury and risk of drowning by converting open canals to buried pipelines

SUPPORT Deschutes Basin streamflow restoration goals

ENHANCE water quality for agriculture and in rivers and streams

IMPROVE habitat conditions for wildlife, fish, and other aquatic species
