MEETING PURPOSE

Inform the community of the Draft Watershed Plan-Environmental Assessment for the proposed Lone Pine Irrigation District Infrastructure Modernization Project and answer questions about the assessment.

DISTRICT FACTS

2,369 acres irrigated

22 irrigators served

15 miles of open canals
and pipelines

Up to **11,800** acre-feet of
water diverted every year

~19% of diverted water
lost to seepage, evaporation,
and operational spills

PROPOSED PROJECT MEASURES

REALIGN the District's conveyance system to achieve optimal efficiency.

IMPROVE District infrastructure by installing 10.9 miles of buried pressurized pipe, upgrade associated turnouts, and decommission 9.7 miles of open canal.

CONSTRUCT a new river crossing across the Crooked River.

POTENTIAL PROJECT BENEFITS

PROTECT up to 1,600 acre-feet of water per year in the Deschutes River.

REDUCE District operation, maintenance, and replacement costs.

IMPROVE irrigation water delivery reliability and District operation and maintenance efficiency.
