Inform the community of the Draft Watershed Plan-Environmental Assessment for the proposed Klamath Drainage District Infrastructure Modernization Project, receive public comments, discuss the project, and answer questions.

DISTRICT FACTS

27,000 acres served

15 irrigators served

30 miles open canals
to convey water

3 pumping plants

PROPOSED PROJECT MEASURES

EXTEND the North Canal and connect it to P1 lateral

INSTALL fish screen at North Canal Diversion on the Klamath River

MODIFY the North Canal to increase flow capacity

UPGRADE two pump stations

INSTALL flow monitoring and automated gates throughout the District

PROJECT BENEFITS

SAVE water by reducing conveyance inefficiencies

IMPROVE irrigation water management and agricultural water supply

IMPROVE water quality in the Klamath River

INCREASE critically needed wildlife habitat

PREVENT fish entrainment in canals and drains
