MEETING PURPOSE

Inform the community of the Draft Watershed Plan-Environmental Assessment for the proposed Arnold Irrigation District Infrastructure Modernization Project and answer questions about the assessment.

DISTRICT FACTS

PROPOSED PROJECT MEASURES

4,384 acres irrigated

INSTALL 13.2 miles of pipe along the District's Main Canal and flume

REMOVE the existing, aging flume

646 irrigators served

UPGRADE 88 District-owned turnouts to pressurized deliveries

39 miles of open canals and pipelines to convey water

POTENTIAL PROJECT BENEFITS

SAVE up to 10,526 acre-feet of water/year by piping

Up to **150** cfs of water diverted

PROTECT up to 10,123 acre-feet of water/year in the Deschutes River during the non-irrigation season

~39% of diverted water lost to seepage

IMPROVE irrigation water delivery reliability and District operation and maintenance efficiency

REDUCE public safety risk by piping the Main Canal
