5,888 acres irrigated

72 miles pipelines and open canals to convey water

11 screened diversions

2 reservoirs

2 hydroelectric plants

POTENTIAL PROJECT OPPORTUNITIES

SAVE water by reducing water conveyance inefficiencies

IMPROVE irrigation water management and agricultural water supply

IMPROVE irrigation water delivery reliability to ensure irrigators receive the water they need, when they need it

INCREASE streamflow in the Hood River and some of its tributaries

ENHANCE water quality for agriculture and the environment

IMPROVE habitat conditions for wildlife, fish, and other aquatic species

MINIMIZE public safety risk by converting open canals to buried pipelines

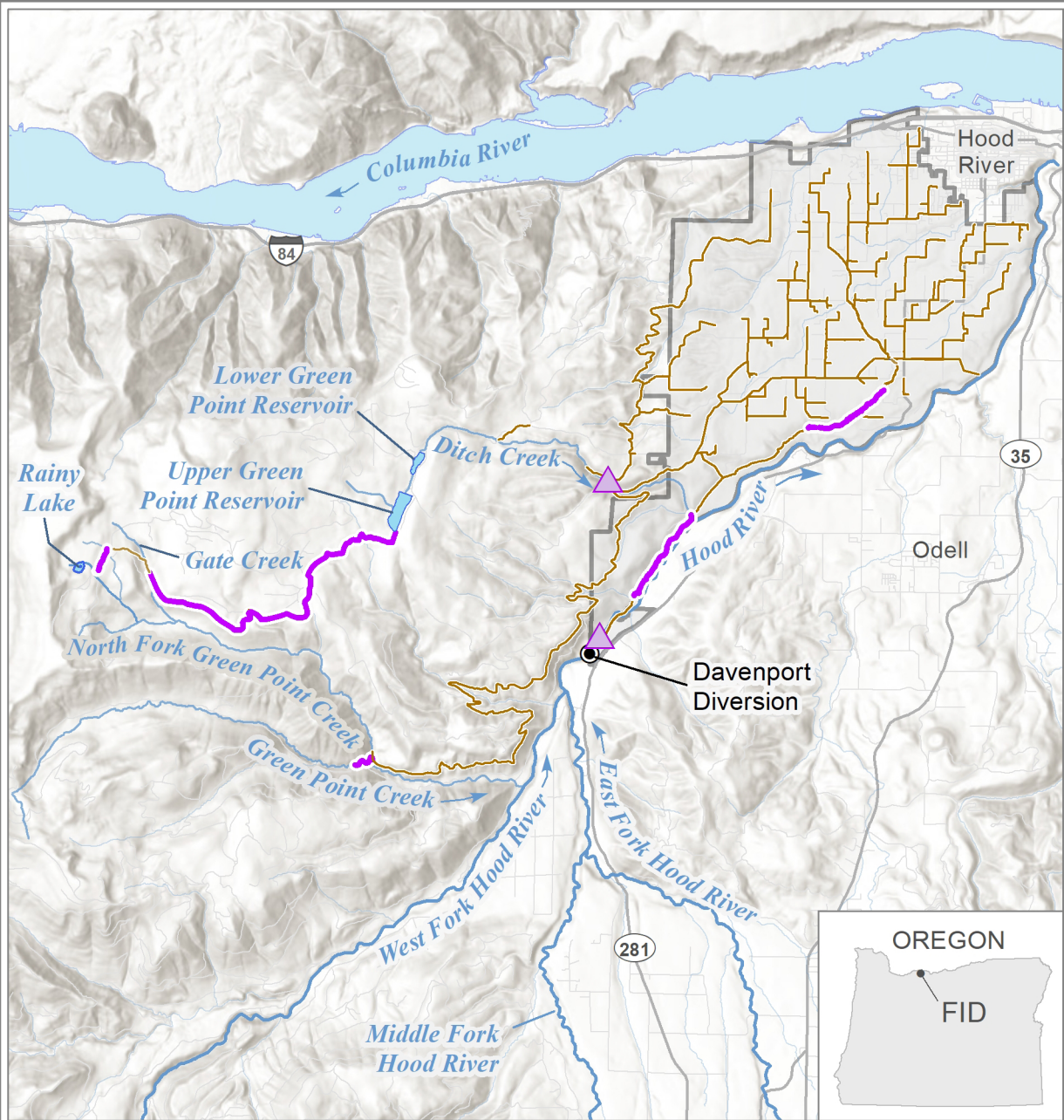
