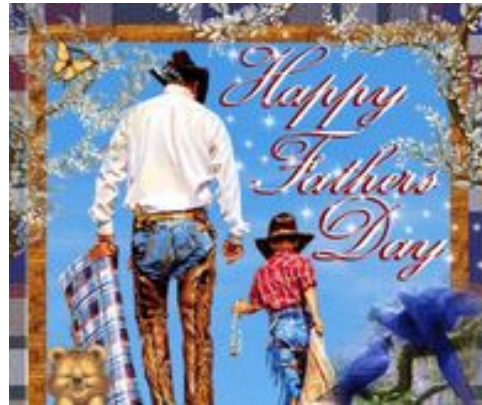

## **BANANA BARS**

**Submitted by Ginger Appleton** (a *BIG* hit at the AESCW Luncheon!)

- 1 ½ CUP SUGAR
- 1 CUP SOUR CREAM
- ½ CUP BUTTER
- 2 EGGS
- 1 ½ CUPS MASHED BANANA
- 2 TSP. VANILLA
- 1 TSP. BAKING SODA
- 2 CUPS FLOUR
- 1 TSP. SALT
- 1 CUP CHOPPED NUTS

Mix together dry ingredients. In separate bowl mix together soft ingredients, then combine with dry. Use jelly roll pan or large Pyrex pan. Bake @ 375° for 20-25 minutes.

### **BROWNE D BUTTER FROSTING**

½ Cube butter-melt & brown, add 2 cups powdered sugar, 1 tsp. vanilla, 3 tbs. milk. Spread over top of Banana Bars.

### **COFFEE FROSTING**

½ cube butter-melted, 2 cups powdered sugar & strong coffee added to desired consistency.

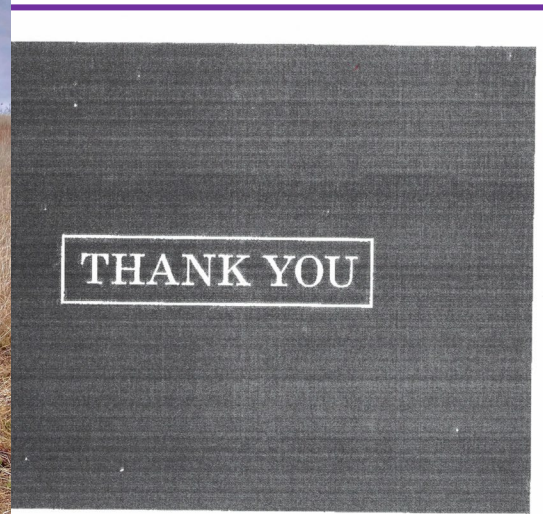




**AES CATTLEWOMEN & AES CATTLEMEN Scholarship Recipients: Thank You's & Photos**

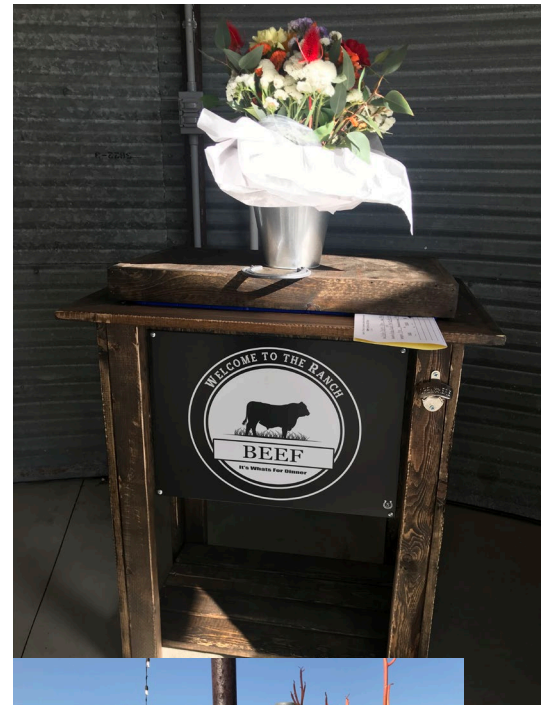
