2. The applicant's **GRADE POINT AVERAGE MUST BE A MINIMUM OF 2.5**, as verified with submission of a current transcript or official grade report to be accepted.
3. The applicant is **required to submit a photo** for the purpose of publicity with the application.
4. The applicant may be required to attend a personal interview.
5. Only **TYPED** applications will be accepted.
6. The **typed** application shall be sent to the scholarship chairperson with a **Postmark no later than April 1** of the scholarship year.
7. Scholarships will be dispersed when your college verifies **Enrollment with a minimum of 12 units**.
