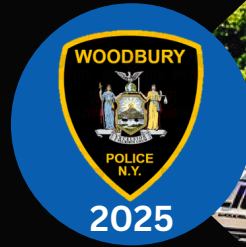

Year 2025 in Review

In 2025, the Town of Woodbury Police Department answered **12,420** calls for service and issued **6485** traffic citations. Officers also made **720** arrests. As part of The Department’s commitment to public service, we performed **11,315** security checks of local businesses, neighborhoods, and vacant houses as well as **1,519** calls for Operation Concern.

The Town of Woodbury Police Department continued to train its Officers and remain vigilant in being ever present to better serve its community and address the ever-expanding influx of international tourism and new growth in the Town. In 2025, the Town has renewed interest in commercial and residential building and growth in our community. The Department worked to continue to provide our excellent attention to detail in how we strive to administer our services. We continued to provide comprehensive training opportunities so that we best prepared our members for the everchanging community we serve. Sergeant K9 Correa

graduated the prestigious **FBI NA Session 295**. We put members on multiple Orange County Task Forces to receive training opportunities and access to resources from our Federal Law Enforcement partners. We provided additional dispatcher training in order to accommodate the increased demand on our telephone systems. We focused our traffic enforcement on critical issues concerning our roadways and how we could safely enforce the rules and regulations. We relied upon our specialized units to get this done efficiently. Those operating on the Town's busy highways, our exchanges are some of the busiest in the county, were able to travel safely thanks to our traffic/commercial vehicle units who proactively patrolled our most congested roadways in order to diminish our growing rate of motor vehicle accidents.

It is my pleasure to serve as the Chief of Police for the Town of Woodbury Police Department and I am honored to work with men and women who are truly dedicated to serve the public. Thank you for letting me provide you with this report.

01. Staffing Report

In 2025, the department focused on fiscal responsibility but strived to get our personnel levels closer to full staff. This is meant to provide the most effective policing services possible to our community but also ensure the well-being of our staff members by not mandating too much overtime.

Ideally, there are 1 full-time Chief, 1 full-time Lieutenant, 6 full-time Sergeants, 2 full-time Detectives, 1 part-time investigator, 15 full-time patrol Police Officers, 5 part-time patrol Police Officers, 3 part-time Court Officers, and 8 part-time School Resource Officers. At the conclusion of the year 2025, the Department was operating with 1 full-time Chief, 1 full-time Lieutenant, 4 full-time Sergeants, a full-time and part-time Detective, 15 full-time Patrol Police Officers, 3 part-time Patrol Police Officers and 8 part-time School Resource Officers.

<p>This program allows residents to submit a form in order to have a Town of Woodbury Patrol Unit monitor the condition of their home for a requested range of dates to ensure that it remains in its present condition as they vacation or leave their home vacant for any other means.</p>	<p>Operation Concern allows residents of the Town of Woodbury to register their loved ones or place themselves on a call list. This list is in place in order to ensure that its participants are called daily. Therefore, if a participant is not reached after various attempts, a patrol unit will be sent to ensure the health and safety of the participant.</p>	<p>The Town of Woodbury Police Department has specially trained police officers who are certified Child Passenger Safety Seat Installers. By appointment, these officers will professionally install your child safety seat. During installation, these officers will provide the owner with safety tips and guidelines to ensure that your child is safe and comfortable.</p>	<p>The Town of Woodbury Police Department works closely with Woodbury Volunteer Ambulance Core in order to provide excellent emergency medical care for our residents. The majority of our officers are certified NYS Emergency Medical Technicians.</p>

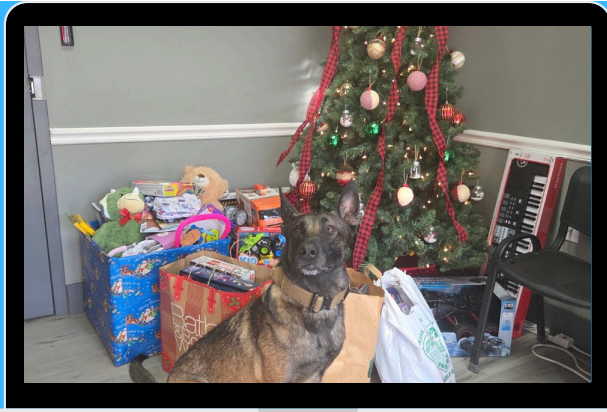
