FIRST AND LAST DAY OF CLASSES

August 9, 10, & 11: First day of classes December 3, 4, & 5: Semester ends

CLASS HOLIDAYS

*Classes WILL meet every week throughout the semester EXCEPT: NO classes Fall Break: October 2-8, 2021.

*Classes WILL NOT dismiss for any holidays: Class will meet on Monday, September 6 – Labor Day!

*Wednesday Acting Class may be moved to another time for final dress rehearsal for a large musical, if produced. Students will be given plenty of advanced notice.

ATTENDANCE, SICKNESS and INCLEMENT WEATHER

*Masks are required for all unvaccinated students.

*Attendance is required at every class. Classes are cumulative.

* DO NOT attend class sick unless cleared for COVID and fever-free for 24 hours.

*Classes will dismiss only if Bowing Green City Schools close for

inclement weather. Excessive cancellations could change the semester schedule by 1 week.

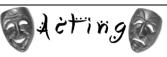

CLASS PERFORMANCES

Students are required to participate in end-of-semester final performances to exhibit development of class concepts. Each class performs 1 day TBA.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS



Group games & exercises reinforce weekly concept. Classes will feature a new play each week – usually one produced by **Xclaim!** in past, but not always. Students

will explore that story & characters while focusing on individualized growth plans and challenges in physicality and expression. Students are recommended to stay in their age group, but some exceptions may be allowed.

Acting 1 is for those with little experience, who haven't taken acting class or age 7-10. Class will focus on foundations of acting and measuring personal growth.

Acting 2 is for those with considerable experience or 3 or more years of acting class, suggested ages 10-15. Class will focus more on director feedback to challenge student presentation to increase growth and confidence.

Acting 3 is for those with considerable experience or 5 or more years of actin class, suggessted ages 15-Adults. Class will move at a fast pace, cover advanced concepts in vocal expression and stage movement, and require reading and memorization.

ALL ACTING CLASSES will perform memorized content for the class final performance the first weekend in December.
