Areas which are off limits. The main barn is a full service boarding stable. Please respect their privacy. We have rented only the two indoor arenas in the Upper guest barns; a hunter/jumper show will be using the outdoor arenas and most of the lower stabling. Please stay on bridle paths and out of outdoor arenas. The area set aside for hand-grazing is under the announcer's tower.

Arenas & Footing. Two indoor arenas: one 100'x225', the other 75'x150', both Equi-Base footing (sand mixed with Geotek fabric over rubber matting). In-Hand classes will be held in the smaller arena Saturday morning; all other classes will be held in the larger arena. Dressage classes 132-136 (Intro & Training 1) and Western Dressage classes 221-223 & 225 (Intro & Basic 1) might be scheduled in a 20m x 40m court; see ride time announcement for final determination. All other tests will be ridden in a 20m x 60m court. Schooling hours will be posted at show office and published with ride times. **All arenas, lunge rings and bridle paths close at 8:30PM**

Dogs and other animals not entered in the show are not allowed at DevonWood Equestrian Centre. Service animals may apply for a permit at the show office. For your animals' safety, please leave them at home. Do not leave them in the car or trailer as temperatures can quickly become dangerous to their health.

Feed & hay are available from local retailers.

Food will not be readily available on the upper show grounds. There are a variety of restaurants within a ten-minute drive. Concessions will be available at the Hunter/Jumper schooling show in the lower show area.

Lungeing. Two of the white round pens outside the upper guest barn will be reserved for our lungeing. No free lungeing or turn-out in lunge pens. No lungeing is permitted anywhere else on the grounds. Lunge pens open 6:30AM-8:30PM.

RV Parking/Camping. A limited number of RV parking spaces with electrical hookups are available for purchase; spaces will not be assigned. Entire rig must fit within space, both length and width, to ensure clear fire lane. Trailers and tow vehicles may park outside the main facility gates at no fee.

Security. Exhibitors are advised that it is their responsibility to secure valuables and their stall areas. DWEC, CASHC, AHA, its members, agents, employees and volunteers accept no responsibility for losses sustained or caused by any exhibitor.

Sharps Containers for medical waste (needles, syringes, etc.) are mounted in the barn aisles. A \$100 fine per violation will be passed on to the violator for medical waste found in your area or if you are found disposing of materials improperly.

Smoking (including vaping) prohibited everywhere on the grounds. DevonWood is a 100% smoke- and vape-free facility. If you smoke or vape, please do so in your vehicle, outside the main gates.

Stabling. 26 permanent box stalls with full doors in Upper Guest Barn, all 12'x12' with mats. Initial bedding provided. No bedding provided in tack stalls. Due to the cost of removing and disposing of bedding and recycling wrappings, all bedding must be purchased on site; no outside bedding is permitted. Stalls may not be resold or sublet by exhibitors. Indicate stabling preference on entry but realize that stalls will be prioritized based on horse's size, sex, and length of stay, not just on postmark date. Stalls available Friday noon through Sunday evening. Entries received after these stalls are sold will be assigned stalls in the lower stables (10x10 with full doors, no mats).

Early arrivals/Late departures. If you need to arrive at DevonWood prior to 2PM April 24th or stay after 6PM on April 26th it must be approved by and contracted with DevonWood Equestrian Centre, LLC. If you arrive early without making prior arrangements, the gate will be locked and admission denied. Please contact the show manager, **Kaye Phaneuf @ (503) 880-3892** for details.

Directions. From I-5 south from Portland/north from Salem to Sherwood/Tualatin exit, #289. West on Nyberg Road (Nyberg Road becomes Tualatin/Sherwood Hwy) and go five miles to Hwy 99W. Turn south and go three miles to 25033 SW Pacific Hwy, on your right just past Brookman/Chapman Rd. Gate code will be shared via confirmation e-mail and posted at main gate on day of arrival.

Coming from the south? To avoid traffic in Tualatin/Sherwood and if your rig is not too long to make a U-turn, you may prefer to: Take Aurora/Donald exit #278. West on Ehlen/McKay Rd. 6.5 miles to end. Right (north) on Hwy 219 3.4 mi to first traffic signal. Right on Springbrook 1 mi to Hwy 99E. Right on Hwy 99E. After approx. 4 miles, just past railroad trestle, see DevonWood entrance on left. This is a four-lane divided highway; make a U-turn at Brookman/Chapman Rd (unprotected turn) or continue north .75 mi to Sunset Blvd (traffic signal, protected U-turn).

Schedule of Fees

Entry Fees

Entries must be submitted on the official entry form, accompanied by full payment, and postmarked or hand delivered to the show secretary beginning March 4th and no later than April 4th. No entries will be taken over the phone or by fax, and no entries accepted without payment. Copies of the horse's registration certificate and all current membership cards must be enclosed with the entry. Entry Confirmation will be sent via email to the legible email address on your entry form. Please review it as soon as it arrives to avoid delays in the show office when you arrive at the show.

Until closing date: all fees returned. **After closing date:** Fees will be refunded upon receipt of a Vet certificate to the show secretary by April 23rd. Facility fees will only be refunded if the entry was not on the grounds. **After April 23:** no refunds.

Payments

Full payment is required for the balance of the entry for an entry to be processed. CASHC accepts checks and money orders, Do not send cash with mailed entries. In fairness to all exhibitors, open checks are not allowed for the initial entry. If an open check is sent, it will be closed for the amount due at the time the entry is processed and will be deposited. Postdated checks will not be accepted. Submission of entry to us is your intent to show and acceptance of our show rules. All debts incurred at the show must be settled before removing a horse from the grounds.

Passing a bad check is a crime. It is the competitor (or payee's) responsibility to ensure that there are sufficient funds to make payment for the total balance of the entry. Entries that arrive without payment will not be processed.

Check should be made payable to "Cascade Arabian Sport Horse Club". All payments will be deposited immediately after closing date and thereafter upon receipt. Foreign competitors checks must indicate payment in USD.

Rules and General Information

Rules, Violations and Penalties.

1. Membership, registration and other rule violations will subject the violator to be disqualified.
2. All classes are to be conducted in accordance with the rules of AHA. Judging, class specifications, rules and conduct shall be in accordance with the current USEF/EC Rulebook.
3. In the event of any rule violation which necessitates a disqualification of any entry, Show Management will make the necessary corrections and submit the results to the AHA office.
4. All decisions made by the Judge and/or Show Management are deemed final and cannot be protested.

Abbreviations. If the class title does not list the breed, the class is open to Arabian, Half Arabian and Anglo Arabians.

AATR = Adult Amateur to Ride (19 yrs & over)

ATH = Amateur to Handle (any age, adults & juniors)

ATR = Amateur to Ride (any age, adults & juniors)

HA/AA = Half-Arabian / Anglo-Arabian

JTR = Junior to ride (18 & under)

TOC = Test of Choice (You pick any one test of the level)

Be sure to specify which test on your entry blank

Amateur Status. Adults competing in classes for amateurs must meet the criteria for amateur certification as defined by USEF.

Awards will be given to first place and ribbons through six places, to eight in equitation.

Call for Classes. It is the exhibitors' responsibility to follow how quickly classes are progressing and to promptly present themselves when the gate person calls for their class. The public address system is considered a courtesy to the exhibitors and its function or coverage of areas cannot be guaranteed. No refunds will be made solely because of sound system inadequacy or failure.

Changes of Handler/Rider. Please fill out a handler or rider change form, including signatures, correct association numbers and required documentation, in the show office prior to the start of the class. This will ensure that points are recorded correctly for qualifying purposes.

Delay of Class (more commonly known as a "Gate Hold"). In classes where horses compete collectively, when it is found that a gate hold must be requested by an exhibitor, such request shall be made to the Paddock Manager (gate person) prior to the close of judging of the class immediately before the class requiring the gate hold. The reason for the request must be stated. The gate hold will be a maximum of three (3) minutes. In classes where horses compete individually, failure to check in with the Paddock Manager or to enter the competition arena at the assigned time will result in elimination.

Office hours. The show office will be open Friday from 2-8PM; thereafter from one hour before first class until 30 minutes after the last class of the day for the remainder of the show. Show office phone is (360) 687-2256.

Refusal/Removal of Entries. Management reserves the right to hold classes conditionally, or cancel entries of any contestant, as stated in USEF Rules. The show committee reserves the right to remove any agent, owner, groom, trainer, manager, coach or handler, horse or rider from the show who has shown an objectionable attitude or behavior towards its management, or previous unsportsmanlike behavior, without being liable for compensation or damages. The Region 4 AHA Board of Delegates has directed that entries must be refused from anyone who has an outstanding obligation to a Region 4 affiliated club or show. Refunds will not be given to exhibitors evicted for cause.

Scheduling Changes. Management reserves the right to make changes of arenas, judges or class order to facilitate time schedule and conditions. Competition management reserves the right to cancel, combine or split classes at its discretion. All changes will be posted on the announcement board in the office and the appropriate announcements made during the competition. Classes with no entries by closing date may be canceled. If entries warrant, a second judge will be hired.

Ride Times. Ride times will be e-mailed at least one week prior to the show to those who submit a legible email address and posted on [Facebook](#) prior to the show. Final ride times will be posted at the show office by 6pm on Friday April 23rd. Responsibility for obtaining ride times from show management remains with the competitor.

Scoring Systems. If a mathematical scoring error on the score sheet is discovered, it must be reported to Show Secretary within one hour of the official posting of the scores from the last scored class of that competition day or the error will stand with no change in class placings. Please claim all dressage and western dressage test sheets and In-Hand score sheets at the show; they will not be mailed.

Scratched Classes. After the close of entries, horses may be scratched from one or more classes at the owner's option. No fees will be refunded. Please scratch horses with the Show Secretary. If you don't show up for an assigned ride time, this Competition reserves the right to scratch you from all remaining dressage rides and offer them to other exhibitors.

Wait-listed Entries. Entries received after closing date are not guaranteed accommodation. For that matter, neither are entries received before closing date, if all times are filled. **Enter early!** Every effort is being made to accommodate all those who want to participate, but since there are a limited number of slots for Dressage, Western Dressage and Sport Horse In-Hand, those classes may fill before the closing date. If that happens, entries will be placed on a waiting list in postmark order.

List of Classes

SATURDAY MORNING • SPORT HORSE IN-HAND

Please be familiar with USEF Rule Book, Arabian Chapter, AR-17 Sport Horse Section.

In Hand order of go will be assigned and posted in the Show office and on [Facebook](#) Friday evening. Order of Go for Sport Horse In-Hand classes will ultimately be determined by the gate person with consideration to handlers presenting multiple horses. Show management reserves the right to use the Open Card system. Classes may not be held in order of class number. You must be ready to present your horse when you are called.

Classes at this show **will not be split by type**, but in all Sport Horse classes -- In-Hand, Under Saddle and Show Hack -- tack and appointments must match one discipline, Dressage or Hunter. Much Hunter tack/attire is legal for Dressage, and conservative casual attire with running shoes is recommended for handlers of either type, but you may not mix-and-match, for example, a shanked bit and a rhinestone browband on the same snaffle bridle. Protective headgear is recommended for all handlers.

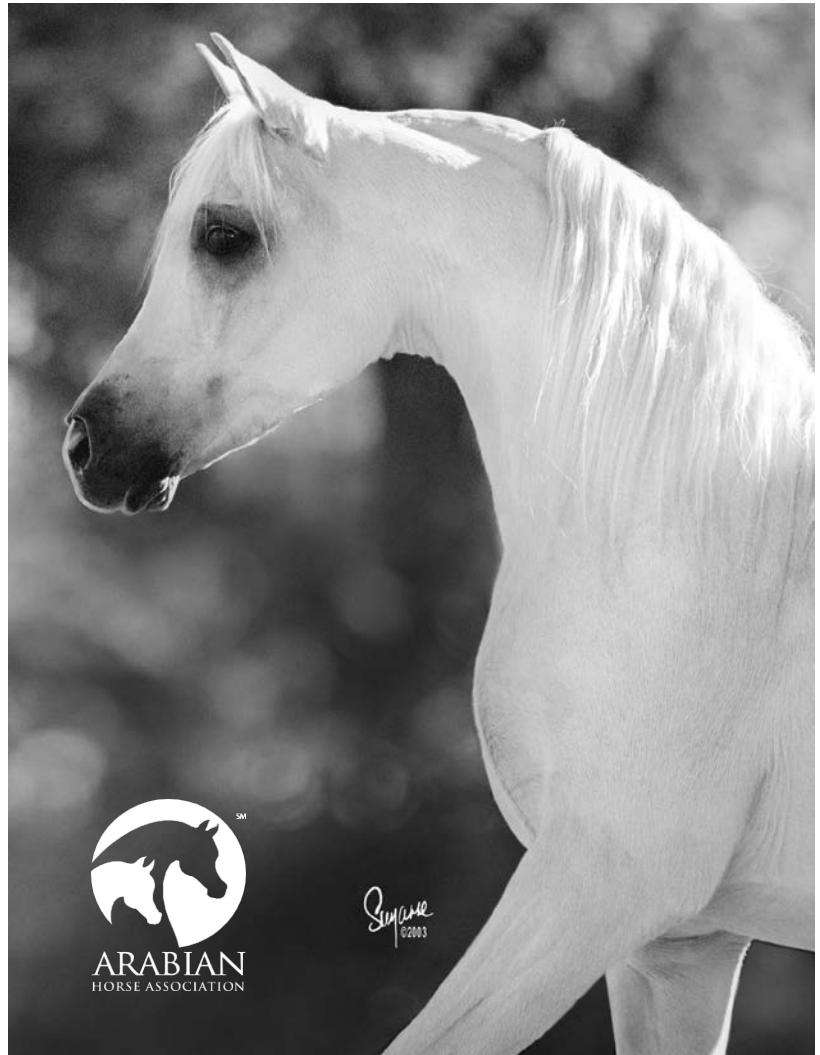

USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards Program Rules

General Information:

1. Program year is December 1 through November 30.
2. Scores may be earned in any USDF region.
3. Late nominations, applications and results submissions will not be accepted.

Rider Eligibility & Requirements:

1. Rider must have a USDF Group Membership that is recorded by the Group Member Organization (GMO) at the time the scores are earned.
2. Riders affiliated with an International GMO must declare a USDF region.
3. Owner must have at least a USDF non-member number at the time the scores are earned.
4. Horse must have at least a USDF Horse Identification Number at the time the scores are earned.
5. Rider must submit a one-time yearly online nomination and \$35 nomination fee for each horse/rider combination no later than 14 days after the last day of the first competition. The nomination fee must be paid annually.
6. Riders may change their division status during the program year. A rider's status will be determined at the end of the program year.
7. Rider must submit scores to USDF online no later than 21 days after the last day of the competition.
8. Only USDF members in good standing are eligible to compete in the USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards Program and receive awards.

Award Divisions & Levels:

1. Four award divisions will be recognized per region:
 - a. Open: from the beginning of the calendar year the rider reaches age 22, not a USEF Adult Amateur (AA), not a non-professional.
 - b. Junior/Young Rider (Jr/YR): up until the end of the calendar year the rider reaches age 21.
 - c. AA: from the beginning of the calendar year the rider reaches age 22 and possess a current USEF AA card.
 - d. Non-Professional: from the beginning of the calendar year the rider reaches age 22, not a current USEF AA, not a professional.
2. Seven levels (freestyle, pas de deux and quadrille not included) will be recognized per division. Exception: only 6 levels are recognized in the open division:
 - a. Introductory (only in Jr/YR, AA and non-professional divisions)
 - b. Training
 - c. First
 - d. Second
 - e. Third
 - f. Fourth
 - g. FEI – combination of Prix St. Georges, Intermediate I, Intermediate II and Grand Prix scores.
3. Equivalencies listed in the current *USDF Member Guide* are eligible. Tests not listed as equivalencies will not be eligible.
4. Preliminary standings will be ranked using a median of all eligible scores and will be available on the USDF website.
5. Final awards standings will be based on the rider's region of primary residence in the USDF database as of November 30.

Score requirements:

1. Introductory Level:
 - a. Must have a minimum of five scores
 - b. From three different judges
 - c. From three different competitions
2. Training through Fourth Levels (levels may not be combined to meet requirements):
 - a. Must have a minimum of five scores
 - b. From three different judges
 - c. From three different competitions
 - d. At least one score must be earned from the highest test of the level
3. FEI Level (levels may be combined to meet requirements):
 - a. Must have a minimum of four scores
 - b. From three different judges
 - c. From three different competitions

Prizes:

1. Up to ten placings per division/level will be recognized.
2. Ribbons will be mailed to the rider.
3. Certificates will be available online.

Competition Management Requirements:

1. Any non-USEF-licensed/non-USDF-recognized competition may participate.
2. To participate, competition management must submit online application and \$25 participation fee to USDF at least 30 days prior to the start date of the competition.
3. The prize list must be submitted to USDF no later than 14 days prior to the competition.
4. Competition judges must be one of the following:
 - a. Current USDF L Graduate, with or without distinction (highly recommend USDF L Graduates with distinction), which has met USDF continuing education requirements and Safe Sport training. USDF L Graduates with distinction are eligible to judge FEI classes.
 - b. USEF or FEI-licensed or retired dressage judge.
5. FEI classes must be judged by USEF or FEI-licensed or retired dressage judges or USDF L Graduates with distinction.
6. Competition arenas must be in compliance with US Equestrian DR 126 for level 1 competitions.
7. Competition results must be submitted to USDF via the USDF Electronic Results Submission Standard (ERSS) format (using the USEF Universal Spreadsheet Template) no later than 21 days from the end date of the competition.

ATTENTION COMPETITORS

Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct applicable numbers (AHA and USDF) for horse, owner, riders, handlers, and trainer, before the day(s) of the competition.

The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward national awards.
