- 6. Self-addressed, stamped #10 envelope
- 7. A recent photo of applicant. Please write your name on the back. Photo will not be returned.

#### Postmark Application Deadline: 04/30/2022

- Applications postmarked after the deadline will not be accepted; no extensions or exceptions.
- Applications sent by fax, email or hand delivered will not be accepted; no exceptions.
- INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED OR REVIEWED.
