

What is PMU/Cosmetic Tattooing?

PMU/cosmetic tattooing, also known as micro-pigmentation, is a form of temporary tattooing where specialized pigments are inserted into the dermis layer of the skin using very fine needles. Clients usually choose to have PMU in the form of shading for eyebrows, eyelids, or lips to enhance their looks and to minimize the need for daily makeup application.

What is Microblading?

Done either manually or by machine, it a technique where pigment is inserted in the skin in the style of hair strokes.

What are Ombre/Powder Brows?

Done with a machine, it is a technique of applying pigment in the skin to softly add shading resembling a "powder" makeup application. Can be customized to very soft and subtle or more bold and defined. *Best option for clients with oily or mature skin.

What are Combo Brows?

Can be done manually or with a machine, it is a technique of inserting pigment in the skin with BOTH hairstroke and ombre/powder techniques. Can also be customized to soft and subtle or more bold and defined.

*Best option for clients with thicker brow hairs or over tweezed and thin brows.

What is Lash line Enhancement?

Done by machine, it is a technique of inserting pigment along your lash line as "eyeliner" but subtly enough that there is no detectable line outside of your eyelashes. This gives the illusion of fuller lashes and defines your eyes.

What is Lip Blushing?

Done by machine, it is a technique where pigment is inserted into your lips very gently in layers to enhance the shape, fullness and color of your lips by a subtle tint. They will be bold in color at first, but lighten 50-60% once fully healed.



How long does cosmetic tattooing last?

Typically it can last anywhere from 1-3 years after your perfecting session touchup. Age, skin care, skin type, sun exposure, and how well you take care of them during the healing process all effects how long it lasts. *This applies to all of our pmu services.

Does cosmetic tattooing hurt?

We use topical numbing on all of our procedures, so typically there is little to no pain.

How long does each service take?

Brows: 2-3 hours

Lashline Enhancement: 1.5-2 hours

Lip Blushing: 2.5-3 hours

*Time can vary depending on if any corrective work is required.

Who is an ideal candidate for cosmetic brow tattooing?

- Anyone who has sparse/thin/light eyebrows
- Anyone who has uneven or over tweezed eyebrows
- Anyone who wants fuller more defined eyebrows
- Anyone who doesn't want to fill your brows in daily
- Anyone who wants to define your eyes and add youth

Who is an ideal candidate for lash line enhancement?

- Anyone who wants to add more definition around their eyes
- Anyone who wants their lash line to look fuller
- Anyone who has trouble applying eyeliner in their lash line
- Anyone who no longer wants to apply eyeliner

Who is an ideal candidate for lip blushing?

- Anyone who has uneven lips
- Anyone who has pale lips
- Anyone who has filler



- Anyone who wants fuller looking lips
- Anyone who has lost definition over the years

Can you get cosmetic tattooing done after Botox or filler?

For lip blushing, it is recommended you wait 2 months after filler or wait to get filler till after your second lip blushing session.

For lash line enhancement, there is no wait since the lash line cannot be affected by Botox or filler.

For brow tattooing, if you REGULARLY receive treatment, wait at least one week after treatment to allow Botox or filler to settle. Botox may be used to lift and alter brows so for anyone who is new to it, we recommend waiting at least 2 weeks after your treatment to see if you are happy with your Botox results before you have your brows done.

Is there any downtime?

Scabbing is a natural part of the healing process! It is important that the aftercare is strictly followed for optimal results. Typically for lips the scabbing is done after 5 days and for eyeliner and brow services the scabbing will stop after 7-9 days.

How often do you need to get a touchup?

Typically, we recommend every 1-2 years but it all depends on your skin type, age, skin care, sun exposure and use of spf! People with oily skin can require touchups on their brows more frequently.

Do appointments require consultation?

Consultations are only required if you have already had any cosmetic tattooing done by an artist not at RejuvePod. Some work we cannot correct, but we now offer saline salt removal!

What is Saline Salt Removal?

This is procedure involves tattooing a saline and salt solution into the skin to cause the pigment to scab out of the skin. Multiple sessions may be required and the appointment can't be booked without a consultation.
