



Daily Program

NCC's Equestrian Camp offers hours of riding time and hands-on experience with a dual focus: teaching horsemanship; and nurturing the bond between horse and rider. Each student will receive personal attention to develop confidence in interacting safely with the horses, and to build their knowledge. Afternoons, evenings, and weekends are filled with a variety of activities listed in the sample schedule.
