




Summary

Generally, listener reaction to this song was negative. When asked to rate this song on a scale from 1 to 10, reviewers reported a 5.1 on average, which ranks this song in the 16th percentile of all songs analyzed by Crowd Review. 





Reviewer Rating Distribution




Comment Sentiment Analysis
