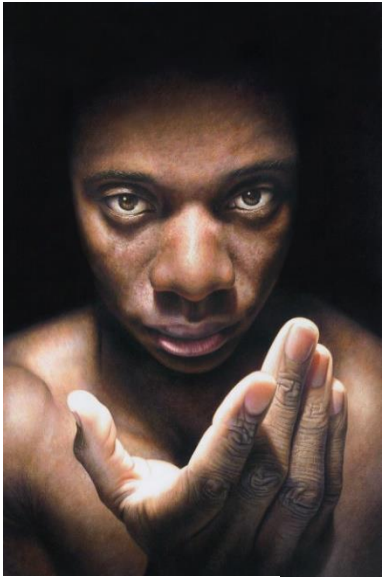


Dramatic Portraits in Colored Pencil
