Dear Inch-holder,

Thank you for helping us make 2019 a successful water year.

As a reminder, we are asking for each inch-holder to continue practicing these changes.

1. Water **will not** be delivered without a formal request from the inch-holder for their water. Please make sure to call and request your water deliveries. If we do not get a call, e-mail, or letter making the request to deliver water, we will not open your headgate. To request your water please call: 303-423-6010 or e-mail nmccoy@churchditch.org.
2. There are flumes and headgates that will need and continue to be replaced. Per the Rules and Regulations (see attached), flumes are the responsibility of the inch-holder. If your flume is deemed to not accurately measure water, you will be asked to replace the flume. You will have 45 days from the date of the notice to replace the flume. The Authority will have a list of vendors that carry flumes, and staff will be happy to help with installation. Flumes that are not replaced by the inch-holder within the 45 days will be replaced by the Authority, and billed back to the inch-holder.

Finally, please join us for the annual inch-holder meeting on March 26, 2020 at 6:00 PM, at the Apex Recreation Facility in the Randall Room. The address for this location is 13150 W. 72nd Ave., Arvada CO. This year's presentation will include a brief history of the Church Ditch, review of water delivery practices, a general overview of the 2019 water year, company activities and CWCB CIP progress update. There will also be a light meal provided.

ARTICLE II

Church Ditch Water Users

2.1 Responsibilities of Users

2.1.15. Measurement of Water All headgates shall have approved measuring and recording devices installed prior to the current irrigation season, as follows:

- (a) Each headgate shall have an accurate measuring device, approved in writing by the Authority.
- (b) Each headgate receiving over 100 inches shall have an accurate recording device, approved in writing by the Authority.
- (c) Measurement and recording devices shall be installed at the Contractual User's expense, and shall be located as close as practical to the headgate serving the Contractual User
- (d) All charts from such recording devices shall be made available for inspection by the Manager.
- (e) Measuring and recording devices shall be inspected by the Manager or his designee at least annually to assure that they are in operable condition.
- (f) Failure to have or to maintain access to a measuring device can and will result in curtailment or termination of water deliveries.
