Superintendent and was paid additional compensation for acting as Superintendent for the irrigation season. Church Ditch was called out of priority August 6th and staff is working on vegetation control, including tree removals. Mr. McCoy has given ERC approval to move forward with

the replacement process of the Cheyenne culvert in Golden. Jefferson County has accepted responsibility for the replacement/repair of the W. 80th Ave. near the 12325 W. 80th Ave. Jefferson County continues to wait for a formal inspection of the W. 80th culvert from CDOT. Mr. McCoy will inform Jefferson County of the potential of the ditch being opened up should the culvert fail. Staff have cut a fire break adjacent to the San Marino subdivision.
