Maintenance

Mr. McCoy provided updates to multiple areas along the ditch. ERC is awaiting a response from the City of Golden regarding the re-location of the utilities crossing the Cheyenne Culvert. Mile High Tree Care will be removing trees on W. 74th Ave. and staff will finish grading when conditions dry out. The bridge at 12335 W. 80th Ave. is expected to have the deck poured the week of 3/11. Staff have mobilized near W. 44th Ave. and Easley Rd. to begin extensive vegetation removal. Staff has also been working on cleaning up the Woman Creek facility. Maintenance bridges have been installed at 100th and Simms. Additionally, Mr. McCoy discussed

a car that entered the ditch at 100th and Simms and will notify board members as quickly as possible after such events. Mr. McCoy has reached out to the City of Westminster to explore the installation of guardrail in this area. Mr. Pacheco's new truck is scheduled to be built the second week of April. HVAC work completed in the shop include a replaced overhead heater, replacement of ceiling fans, and a new exhaust fan.
