Pierogi

Home made by Babcia, melt in your mouth dough. Our flavours include:

- Potato & cheddar cheese
- Meat
- Potato & cottage cheese with onion
- Sauerkraut & mushroom

Schnitzel Dinner

Lightly breaded, perfectly seasoned and crisp chicken or pork schnitzel.



Cabbage Roll Dinner

Traditional home cooked cabbage rolls stuffed with ground pork and rice, topped with tomato sauce.

Farmer's Sausage Dinner

Our sausage has a perfect balance of flavour and each bite is moist, juicy, and has a bold meaty flavour.



Beef Goulash with Potato Pancake Dinner

Traditional hearty beef stew topped over our crispy pan fried potato pancakes.

Rib Dinner

Our fall off the bone ribs are smothered in our homemade bbq sauce.



Schnitzel on a bun (Chicken or Pork)

Lightly breaded with eggs and breadcrumbs and seasonings, our crispy, light schnitzel served on a fresh kaiser bun with lettuce, tomato, honey mustard and mayo.

Beet Salad

Cucumber & Dill

'Mizeria' cold and crisp cucumbers tossed in babcias creamy dill dressing, perfect side to hot crispy pierogies.



Cauliflower & Broccoli with Garlic

Raw cauliflower & broccoli, tossed in a creamy strong garlic dressing. If you're a garlic lover this one's for you.



Creamy Coleslaw

Crispy, finely shredded raw cabbage with just the right amount of home made dressing. Bursting with colour and flavour.



Napoleon Cream Square

Melt in your mouth fresh cream between 2 pastry flaky crusts, sprinkled with powdered sugar.



No Bake Cheesecake
