# **Rules & Regulations**

1. Please refer to the respective breed association rules for class, equipment and operation rules (ApHC, APHA, NSBA). All Breed classes that are run concurrently with an association class will follow the sanctioned class it is held with. Where not concurrent, they will follow ApHC rules, 2019 Official Handbook.

## 2. Registration Requirement:

- **ApHC**/**NSBA** / **APHA:** Photocopies of front and back must be provided with entries or Registration papers must be presented at check-in.
- If entering NSBA, Certificate of Eligibility (for horse) and memberships (owner/rider) can be applied for AT THE SHOW. \*New NSBA Rule for registration requirements, allowing non-registered horses into their program\* https://www.nsba.com/registration

- Novice or Non Pro/Amateur: You must provide proof of eligibility to Show Secretary
- ALL BREED: No registration requirement.

## 3. Membership Requirement:

- Every exhibitor must also hold Manitoba Horse Council membership or their respective Provincial Horse Association (for insurance purposes). Membership for insurance purposes will be available for purchase at show or online: <u>https://manitobahorsecouncil.ca/SignUp</u>. US Residents must hold proof of liability insurance.
- b. Every exhibitor *and* owner must supply their membership card(s) for the appropriate associations (ApHC, NSBA, APHA) to show and acquire points in those respective divisions. If showing in the Non Pro/Amateur divisions, you must also pay for that designation. Memberships can be purchased at the show.
- c. No memberships are required for All Breed Classes.
- 4. Entries:

*Deadlines: Earlybird entry deadline* is June 1, 2019. (Must be paid via etransfer or credit card by this date, or will be considered REGULAR entries).

Online entry deadline July 15, 2019

Post entries are those received after July 15 to 5pm the day prior to the class.

*Gate entries* will be available at an additional fee, horse/rider must both have registration information in office to be eligible to enter at Gate. Gate official must approve your entry. *How to enter?*

<u>Scratches</u> can be made and will be refunded if made by July 18, 2019. Scratches made after the start of the show will not be refunded unless accompanied by Vet or Dr. note. Office fees and half of stabling fees will be retained if a complete Medical scratch and horse is not at show. Stabling fees will be charged if horse remains on grounds.

## 5. Stabling:

**Stall Fees include nights of July 18-20th, 2019.** Arriving before or later will incur \$40/overnight. Early bird price \$100 /stall, \$110 regular, \$115 late. Tack stalls \$80

**Bookings:** Stall bookings will not be accepted without full payment of all stall fees. Stabling with trainer/ranch/group must be requested in the same email or envelope. (See Stabling & RV Form) Early or late arrivals can be arranged, please note this on your entries or email <u>info@caaass.com</u>

- **Day Fee:** All horses showing must pay for a stall (Day fee \$60). Stabled horses have access to warm up, arenas during designated periods and open wash racks.
  - 6. **Facility Use**: Wash rack and warm up arena will be open Thursday noon until the show end time.
  - 7. RV Parking: see RV /Stabling form for booking and fees

Must obey Keystone Facility guidelines and park in designated areas. 15, 30, 50 amp plugs will be available. See RV/Stabling Form to book.

## 9. Juggernaut Youth Award

Juggernaut Computers have generously donated a tablet to the CanAm Triple A Summer Show. This will be going to one of the youth competitors this year.

- How to become eligible: For every youth class competed in, individuals will be entered in the draw for the *Juggernaut Youth Award*. Every youth class is eligible (All Breed, APHA & ApHC) for receiving an entry. For example, if a youth competes in 2 ApHC classes and 3 All breed classes, they will receive 5 entries to the draw.
  - 10. Yearling Jackpot Entry Fee \$100 per division (ApHC, NSBA and All Breed) Details: Points will be accumulated from 3 categories of Yearling Classes. One Longeline, One Yearling in hand Trail and One Yearling halter class. They will be tallied for each Division (ApHC, NSBA or All Breed). Horses do not have to enter all 3 classes. If horse enters more than one division, they are more than one entry and will require more than one entry fee.

## 12. Gamblers Choice Trail

The Gamblers Choice trail is not sanctioned by any association.

- Entry fee is : \$100 (up to July 18<sup>th</sup>, 2019) \$150 on July 19/20<sup>th</sup>. Will be paid out as per the NSBA Payout Table.
- Rules: Course will consist of obstacles of varying degrees of difficulty and varying amount of points. Competitors will have 3 minutes to choose and complete their choice of obstacles.

Obstacles can only be completed once and in any order. No Pattern.

Competitors will receive the listed points for each successfully completed obstacle (as judged by the Gamblers Choice Judge).

Order of Go will be determined randomly, after the walk through.

If a tie should occur, the shortest course time will be the winner.
