#### **Public Comment:**

- Matt Witte from Raisin Township reported that We the People will be hosting a private event on Wednesday, May 22, 2024, 11:00 am, at Hooligans, 113 E. Maumee St., Adrian, MI. The event will feature renowned physicist and mathematician Dr. Douglas Frank, who is currently a full-time national election data analyst.
- Jim Leonard reported that he attended a fireworks seminar and the State of Michigan strongly suggests that individuals obtain permits for fireworks displays. Jim Leonard asked the Board to grant him permission to host fireworks displays and to record the Board's response in the minutes. Jim stated that he will be hosting a private display on May 26, 2024; July 3. 2024; and September 1, 2024. The Board did not respond to Jim's request.

- ➤ Drain Commission: Supervisor Pixley reported that he plans on meeting with Ed Sheffler, who is running for the Drain Commissioner seat in the August Primary. Dave wants to get him up to speed concerning the Central Lenawee Sewer System Fund.
- ➤ Park Committee: Clerk Whited reported that she met with Fleis & Vandenbrink planning manager Lisa Easterwood and Great Lakes Recreation planning manager Stephanie Habers via Zoom. During that meeting, they discussed the purchase of playground equipment prior to filing for the DNR Recreation Passport Grant, which would not cover the cost of the equipment if purchased prior to the filing of the grant. Stephanie stated that she would speak to the Little Tykes vendor to see if they would give the Township the \$40,000 discount on a similar structure that would be purchased in 2025. Lisa also explained that there are two other DNR grant options: Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund and the Land and Water Conservation Fund.
- Roads/Bridges: Supervisor Pixley reported that the Road Commission has not yet started road work in Palmyra Township.
- ➤ FOIA Requests: Clerk Whited reported that she received two FOIA requests: Elite Property Research for information on 6343 Palmyra Road and Applied Environmental for information on 7751 E. US 223. Both requests were promptly fulfilled.

- Supervisor Pixley reported that Michigan Electric Transmission Company withdrew their current request for PA 116 partial termination. They will be working with the landowner and his attorney in filing a Land Division application and a PA 116 Partial Termination application.
