FINANCIAL AGREEMENT

Tuition

Spring Registration before August 1, 2023 – expected registration fee \$20.00 per child:

- First child \$360.00
- Second child \$340.00
- Third child \$320.00

You can also split up the tuition in two installment rates and then the payment will be:

- First child \$190.00
- Second child \$180.00
- Third child \$170.00

First installment rate must be paid by **October 31**, and the second by **January 31**.

Registration after August 1, 2023:

- First child \$380.00
- Second child \$360.00
- Third child \$340.00

You can also split up the tuition in two installment rates and then the payment will be:

- First child \$200.00
- Second child \$190.00
- Third child \$180.00

Additional fees:

Parental Committee - \$20.00 per child

Tuition for religious education (CCD) is \$60.00 and it needs to be paid by October 31.

Deposit for school duties - \$60.00. Each family is required to perform 3 school duties during the school year. After completing all 3 duties, the deposit will be returned.

Being late with paying the tuition

Our school is obligated financially to pay all fees on time (leasing classrooms, bookkeeping fees, regulatory fees, insurance fees, etc.) If any family is late with paying tuition, it creates a risk for additional costs; therefore, we need to impose late fees. The late fee will be **\$10 per child** for each started month; meaning, if you pay your tuition in November, and you have two children, your late fee will be \$20.

Children of the parents, who do not pay the first half of the tuition by January 31 + any late fees, will not be allowed to continue learning in our school.

Fundraising

In order to fund school trip, Christmas play, picnic and several contests, our school organizes two forms of fundraising. For those not interested, you will have an option of buyout.

Valentine's Day Ball

Each year our school organizes Valentine's Day Ball for adults only. On day 4/28/12, PTA decided that each family will be obligated to purchase at least one ticket. The ticket need to be purchased prior to the event.

Shopping Dollars

Each year, we also propose another form of school fundraising. The great thing is that it will not cost you anything and our school will earn 5%. We offer **ShopRite gift cards** for purchase. If you buy a \$100 card, you will have \$100 to spend on your groceries, and our school will earn \$5. **Each family is required to purchase at least \$400.00 worth of gift cards.** You can purchase the gift cards at our table, where you walk into the cafeteria.

For those not interested or those who believe this is too time consuming, etc. will have an option of buyout and can simply pay \$20 out of pocket (per family).

School Duties

In order to keep our children safe, we ask each family to sign up to help and supervise our children during school hours 3 times in a year. The schedule will be

prepared by school and will be available on school's website: www.szkolajezykapolskiego.com. In addition, you will be notified when your turn to supervise is. If you cannot attend on an assigned date, you can always exchange days with another parent. Each family is asked to pay a deposit of \$60.00, which will be returned by the end of the year after completion of all 4 duties.

List of duties

We provide you a list of your duties while supervising our children, because many of you kept asking what they are:

- Those, who supervise kids the whole day at school, bring late children to their classrooms and brings children from their classrooms if they need to picked up earlier.
- 2. Those, who supervise children during lunch, help distribute lunch (pizza, drinks, cookies, etc.) and help cleaning up after lunch.
- 3. Make sure children are not running, screaming, pushing each other, etc.
- 4. Make sure the bathrooms are clean and children do not make mess.
- 5. Make sure that children stay at the cafeteria and do not leave the school or wonder around the school.
- 6. Make sure all doors are closed and the children leave school only under teachers or parents supervision.
