Since opening our doors in May 2025, MMOA has had the privilege of serving fifteen women seeking healing, stability, and restoration. We are especially thankful to celebrate six successful transitions, where women have moved forward into greater independence, sobriety, family reunification, and renewed hope. Each transition represents not just a milestone, but a life touched by compassion, accountability, and faith. We currently have five women still in care.

ON-SITE MANAGER

My name is Jennifer Johnson, and for 16 years I struggled with meth addiction. During that time, I lost custody of my children, damaged relationships with my parents and sisters, and drifted away from many people I loved and cared about. Eventually, my addiction led to legal trouble, and after pleading guilty to possession and paraphernalia charges, I was placed on probation. Still unable to pass a drug test, I was sanctioned to spend 90 days at Masterpiece Ministries of Arkansas.

What I thought was punishment became the very thing God used to save my life.

Masterpiece Ministries gave me hope, structure, accountability, and most importantly pointed me to Christ. I am so thankful God placed these amazing people in my path when I needed help the most. Today, I am 11 months clean, and little by little my relationships with my family and children are being restored.

God has given me a new foundation built on faith, recovery, and the support of people who truly care about me. I now have the privilege of serving as an On-Site Manager, a job I absolutely love because it allows me to encourage women who are walking the same road I once walked.

My name is Rachel Crow, and I would first like to thank Ms. Candace Riner for this opportunity to share a little about my story. My greatest desire is to give back to the community that has helped me get where I am today on this journey of recovery and restoration.

Since coming to Masterpiece Ministries of Arkansas, I have graduated from the Drug Court program, completed the in-house program, and earned more than eleven certificates through recovery and personal development courses. I will celebrate one year with the ministry in June, and I am currently working toward becoming a Peer Support Specialist.

This has been the most remarkable and life-changing program I have ever experienced. Through this program, the support of this community, and most importantly by the grace of God, I have now been clean for two years. Today, I also participate in outreach work through N.A. in other regions, helping encourage and support active addicts who are still struggling.

For the first time in my life, I truly believe I have purpose. I am giving back by helping others find hope and recovery, just as others once helped me. I am a walking miracle, and I know that everything I have achieved has only been possible through God's grace and the support of this ministry.
