DECEMBER 2024



2024 was a wonderful year for Habitat for Humanity New Brunswick (HabitatNB). It is our absolute pleasure to share some hightights with you. We had the privelege of housing nine new families throughout our province this year! In addition to this, we have three more homes nearing completion with occupancy planned in coming weeks. We also have four more homes in early stages of construction.

As exciting as this is, it is really just the beginning of addressing the true housing crisis that is affecting communities throughout our province - and, really, Canada as a whole. According to the results of Habitat for Humanity's third annual Affordable Housing Survey, eight-in-ten Canadians say that buying a home now feels like a "luxury", and many believe that it is simply impossible. The Habitat mortgage model is based on no-down payment, low interest, and payments geared to income. This makes homeownership much more affordable and attainable for families who would not qualify for a traditional bank mortgage.



This is the ultimate goal of the Habitat mortgage model. It is always incredible to witness the happiness and success of our wonderful families.

And then, on August 14th, we had the pleasure of opening a brand new ReStore in Miramichi, located at 2368 King George Highway! It has long been a goal of ours to have a store space in Miramichi and we thank all who made this possible. With this new location, we now have four Habitat ReStores throughout NB to serve you.





Through an innovative partnership between Habitat for Humanity New Brunswick, the Carpenter Millwright College of New Brunswick, the provincial government, and City of Fredericton, four new affordable homes are being built on Demerchant Drive in Fredericton while training new carpenters. Through this partnership, students have an opportunity to participate in a one-year carpentry program which offers 20 weeks in the classroom and 32 weeks on our Habitat build site.

This project combined with Habitat for Humanity's affordable mortgage model will make an incredible difference in the lives of families in need of affordable housing in the Fredericton area as well as helping to solve the skilled trades shortage.

Applications are now being accepted for these soon-to-be constructed homes.
