Fredericton, NB – Today Habitat for Humanity New Brunswick officially welcomed four families into their new homes with a dedication ceremony along with a barbeque to thank its many partners, donors and volunteers who contributed to this build project. These duplexes will provide stability and security for these families through Habitat's affordable homeownership program.

Habitat provides working families with an opportunity to purchase a safe and decent home by partnering with Habitat for Humanity. Our path to homeownership requires hard work, time and dedication by the future homeowners, which helps to ensure their long-term success. Families complete 500 partnership hours and pay an affordable mortgage geared to income.

Since 2019, the federal government has made a total funding commitment of \$1,375,744 towards Habitat New Brunswick (formerly Habitats Fredericton Area, Moncton and Saint John) projects, including these new homes. This funding commitment from the National Housing Co-Investment Fund includes a Black Families Funding investment of \$306,165.

Every Canadian deserves a safe and affordable place to call home. Through the National Housing Co-Investment Fund, the Government of Canada is building vibrant and prosperous communities for Canadians here in Fredericton, and across the country.
