At Room at the Inn, our mission is to provide a safe and supportive environment for all our guests. To ensure the well-being and comfort of everyone in our shelter, we have established a set of rules and guidelines that we kindly ask all guests to follow. These rules are designed to promote a peaceful and respectful atmosphere within our facility.

Room at the Inn Shelter Rules

1. Operating Hours:

- The shelter opens at 6 PM and reservations are held until 7 PM. No entry allowed after 9 PM.
- Shelter closes at 8 AM.
- Shelter grounds are off-limits between 9 AM and 5 PM.

2. Substance Policy:

- Room at the Inn is a drug-free and alcohol-free shelter.
- Any alcohol or drugs must be surrendered upon arrival and will be returned upon departure.

3. Weapon Policy:

Weapons or potential weapons are not allowed within the shelter.

4. Smoking Policy:

- Smoking is prohibited inside the shelter.
- Designated smoke breaks are provided in the evening and morning.
- Tobacco products should be surrendered upon entry.

5. Behavior Expectations:

- Disruptive behavior will result in a single warning.
- Continued disruption or violence is not tolerated and will result in removal from the shelter.

6. Quiet Hours:

Quiet hours are from 10 PM to 6 AM. No group conversations, headphones required.

7. Vandalism:

Vandalism is not tolerated.

8. Belongings:

Personal belongings should not be left at the shelter. They may be disposed of.

9. Personal Hygiene:

• Upon complaints, a guest may be required to shower and/or do laundry before they can return.

10. Keep the shelter clean:

- Maintain a clean and neat cot area.
- Keep common areas clean.
- Throw away all trash.

11. Respect and Non-Discrimination:

- No racial, gender, or ethnic slurs or intimidation allowed.
- Respect for other guests' personal spaces and belongings.

12. Respect and Courtesy:

Treat staff, volunteers, and other guests with respect and courtesy.

13. Compliance with Staff Requests:

• Guests are expected to comply with reasonable staff requests.

14. Lost or Stolen Items:

Room at the Inn is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

15. Smoking any substance or tampering with fire alarm system will result in 30 day suspension.
