

Project Information Sheet Traffic Management and Access

A Traffic Management Plan has been developed by the Project to manage the interface issues between project traffic and other road users. The Traffic Management Plan includes the routes to be taken by project traffic to reduce the impact on other road users.

Access to Site

The Project aims to reduce the number of project vehicles using Adelaide Street by creating a new site access. During the establishment of site works, a limited number of project vehicles will use Adelaide Street to deliver large mobile plant to the site, which will then be used to construct the new access. Once the new access is created, all project traffic will enter and exit via Stirling Street. No debris or materials will be delivered or removed from the site via Adelaide Street.

Notification to Residents

The Project will provide advance notice to residents on Adelaide Street of the day and time that plant deliveries can be expected. When these deliveries are scheduled to occur, there may be a requirement for temporary traffic management to be in place (typically limited to several hours). The Project will advise residents in advance of any temporary changes to access arrangements.

Safety

If you notice debris on local roads that you suspect may have come from the project site, please take a photo and email this to us together with a description and the location.

Over the next few years there is a significant amount of development occurring in the Hazelmere / High Wycombe light industrial area (in addition to the Hazelmere Hub Project). Heavy Vehicle (truck) traffic along Stirling Street should be anticipated by local road users. Road users are encouraged to be extra vigilant when entering intersections, particularly Adelaide Street and Stirling Street, and to allow additional time and space for north and southbound Heavy Vehicle traffic.

Parking

The project's staff and contractors will park all vehicles on site. There should be no additional parking congestion in local streets for the duration of the project.
