Although a little unorthodox, it may have been because my family was both Christian and Jewish. But the message was clear. Traditions are important. They can be the glue that holds groups (and families) together.

If you subscribe to the District Facebook account, GWRRA VA District, you would have seen the adventures of VAL, the Chapter Va-L mascot. He was gnome-napped during Rally in the Valley. His adventures included laying drunk on the sand at the beach, being photographed as the catch of the day, traveling in space aboard the Dragon, visiting the sick and infirmed, sitting aloft as the heralded VIP he is at RITV, attending a parade in support of our troops and visiting the Pitts family. Have fun and enjoy riding with Chapter L. We want all of our riders to relax and enjoy the ride while being among friends that share your passion... riding.


