Dear Ms Tonkin,

Thank you for your email and letter sent to Mayor Mark Irwin in relation to traffic issues discussed at the previous meeting with yourself and the community members.

We have experienced a significant increase in workload over the last 3 months and as such, there has not been any significant progress on the projects that you listed. However, I have provided comments regarding the current status of these projects.

- **Coronation Street & Huntriss Road Intersection** – The City undertook some preliminary consultation with residents and there were some concerns raised that need further investigation. As such, this project will be deferred for consideration under next year’s Black Spot Program submissions, which means that the project (if successful) would be funded in 2024/2025.
- **Paramatta Road & Ewen Street intersection** – The crash frequency has been reducing over recent years, but the City will continue to monitor this intersection to determine if any remedial treatments are required.
- **Pearson Street & Cromarty Road Intersection** – This intersection has only had one reported crash in the last 5-year period on record. While the traffic and congestion issues associated with school activities are acknowledged, this intersection would be considered a low priority at this stage.
- **Pearson Street & Rosewood Avenue Intersection** – As per the notes in your letter, remedial treatments for this intersection would require either additional land from surrounding properties, or removal (banning) of certain movements. Banning of movements would result in a distribution of traffic to other parts of the network, and would therefore need further consideration.

I trust the above is sufficient in responding to your enquiries.
