2026 DIOCESAN SERVICES FUND

The 2026 Diocesan Services Fund (DSF) has begun!!

This is an annual effort of our local Church that provides essential support for 64 ministries that serve those in need. Through your generosity you are:

- Supporting the formation of our future priests
- Serving the poor, feeding the hungry and supporting those in need
- Providing a strong, Catholic education to more than 17,500 students
- Forming the next generation of Catholics through youth and adult faith formation

HOW YOUR GIFT IS USED

27% – Teaching, Evangelizing, and Worship

Through catechesis, worship, and evangelization, the Church's mission to form disciples comes alive.

22% – Nurturing and Strengthening Families

Family ministries nurture the most basic core unit of Christian life by caring for human and spiritual needs of family members.

20% – Promoting, Preparing, and Supporting Clergy

Vocational ministries address the full range of support for the clergy from the beginning stages of discernment to retirement.

14% – Ministering to the Poor, the Sick, and the Incarcerated

Serving the least among us, these ministries bring hope and God's healing grace to those in need.

13% – Rebates to Parishes

When parishes raise funds beyond their goal or welcome new donors, a portion is returned to support local parish needs and ministries.

4% – Special Grants/Aid to Poor Parishes

Grants awarded by Archbishop Vásquez to support ministries serving specific needs within the Archdiocese.

OUR 2026 GOALS ARE \$4,945 (OLPH) AND \$3,762.50 (SJA).

Father Preston would like to reach our goals by **April 15!** Once our goals have been met, please redirect your tithing to the beautification projects happening in our parishes, as well as towards our summer youth camps!

The #1 goal of DSF is 100% parish participation. It does not matter how much someone gives, simply that they give!

As in other years, Archbishop Vásquez has approved the following **INCENTIVES** for the Diocesan Services Fund 2026 appeal:

1. A 75% rebate on every dollar **raised over DSF goal** will be returned directly to our parish community;
2. A 50% rebate on every gift **made by a first-time giver** to DSF will be returned directly to our parish community.
